Prof. Hitesh Deka, Vice-Chancellor, KKHSOU, Guwahati and Prof. P.K. Biswas, Director, STRIDE and Dr. P.V.K. Sasidhar, Director, SOEDS could not attend the Meeting due to their pre-occupations. Dr. Bharat Bhushan, Dr Bijayalaxmi Mishra, Deputy Directors and Dr. Satish Gaikawad, Assistant Director, Research Unit were also present to assist the RCSC proceedings.

At the outset the Chairperson thanked the outgoing members of the RCSC and welcomed the new members. Subsequently, he requested Prof. Barik, Member-Convener of the RCSC to present the Agenda Items.

The Director, Research Unit informed the Members that major part of the admission process to MPhil/ PhD programmes for July 2018 session in 26 Disciplines (PhD in Geology, Geography, Chemistry, Statistics, Physics, Life Sciences, Biochemistry, Gender & Development Studies, Women's Studies, Management, Commerce, History, Political Science, Public Administration, Psychology, Sociology, Anthropology, Library and Information Sciences, Hindi, Social Work, Environmental Science, Nutritional Science, Distance Education, Translation Studies, Nursing, and MPhil in Economics, Chemistry, Sociology, Political Science, Translation Studies, Social Work, Distance Education, Commerce and Geography) including conduct of Entrance Test, Interviews, and recommendations of the selected candidates by the respective DRCs/ School Boards have been completed within a span of two months. He thanked the Schools and concerned Divisions for their support, commitment and efforts in accomplishing the task within the stipulated time. The Members appreciated the efforts of the Research Unit for the systematic accomplishment of the entire process. The Director (RU) shared with the members the details on the number of seats advertised and final selection of candidates, category-wise, adding that the stipulated reservation of seats has been nearly achieved in the selection process. He informed the members that out of 363 (65 MPhil+298 PhD) seats advertised, 198 (32 MPhil + 166 PhD) candidates in total were selected in different disciplines.

The selection of the candidates were done strictly as per the IGNOU Regulations for conduct of Research Programme and judged in terms of candidates' research aptitudes (40% weightage), subject knowledge (40% weightage), and communication skills (20% weightage). The breakup of the selected candidates, Discipline-wise as recommended by the respective DRCs/ School Boards is as follows:

The members observed that in the Discipline of History, eight candidates were recommended by the DRC of History(SOSS) against six vacancies advertised. Although the Discipline had earlier mentioned that the number of seats was likely to increase, the RCSC was of the view that the number of candidates shall not be more than what was advertised. However, the candidates beyond the number of vacancies may be kept in the waiting list.

Director (RU) informed the Committee that meeting of the School Board of SOE (housing M Phil/ Ph D Distance Education) had not taken place and the recommendation of the School Board is pending. However, the list of candidates recommended by the DRC for admission in M Phil/ Ph D Distance Education has been approved by the Vice Chancellor for submission before the RCSC.

Before taking up the agenda items formally, Director Research Unit invited the attention of the members to certain basic issues. While recommending the list of selected candidates, certain disciplines have not mentioned whether the candidates have to do coursework or they are exempted from the same. This may lead to some confusion at the admission stage, as fee charged from candidates with coursework is different from that of candidates without coursework.

The committee after due deliberation resolved that if the recommendation of DRC/ School Board is silent on coursework, admission fee with coursework shall be charged from a candidate. Necessary adjustment in the second year fee shall be made if the concerned candidate is subsequently exempted from coursework by the DRC. Thereafter agenda items were taken up.
