Introduction: STRIDE has conducted UGC approved and HRDC equivalent STP 6 days' workshop on 'Monitoring and Evaluation in Distance Online and Blended Learning' 18-25 January 2023 for Teachers and Academics of SOUs and other ODL Institutions and other Educational Institutions. This STP focused on monitoring and evaluation in distance, online and blended learning, monitoring and evaluation system that inform planning for projects. These components trace a logical train of thought from hypotheses on how the project will bring about change in a specific sector, to the specific objectives needed for these changes, methods for measuring the project's achievement of its stated objectives, and protocols for collecting and analyzing data and information used in the measurement. 'Monitoring is the continuous assessment of the intervention and its environment with regard to the planned objectives, results, activities, and means. It takes place at all levels of management and uses both formal reporting and informal communications. Monitoring enables a stakeholder to review progress and to propose action to be taken in order to achieve the objectives. Monitoring identifies actual or potential successes or failures as early as possible and facilitates timely adjustments to the operations' (Ministry for Foreign Affairs, 1998). 'Evaluation is the systematic process of collecting, analysing and interpreting information that enables judgments to be made about the value of a programme (of learning) and its effectiveness and efficiency in achieving a set of outcomes' (Dolley, 1994). This six days STP was focused on how to plan and implement a project M&E system is explained in some detail through a review of the main steps and approaches required. The role of participation in M&E design and implementation is considered, and how to create a learning environment for projects and design, manage and support a results-oriented monitoring and evaluation system for selfreliance and confidence of participants.

According to NEP 2020 envisions a comprehensive approach to transforming the quality and quantity of research in India. This includes definitive shifts in school education to a more play and discovery based style of learning with emphasis on the scientific method and critical thinking. This includes career counselling in schools towards identifying student interests and talents, promoting research in universities, the multidisciplinary nature of all HEIs and the emphasis on holistic education, the inclusion of research and internships in the undergraduate curriculum, faculty career management systems that give due weightage to research, and the governance and regulatory changes that encourage an environment of research and innovation. All of these aspects are extremely critical for developing a research mindset in the country.

- Discuss the significance of monitoring and evaluation of projects / programme.
- Explain the principles, objectives and processes of project monitoring and evaluation.
- Identify the elements and steps/stages of a monitoring and evaluation plan.
- Create an M&E plan for an upcoming program; and
- Advocate for the creation and use of M&E plans for a project/program/organization.

Participants

There were 28 Teachers and Academics from SOUs, ODL Institutions and other higher Education Institutes had registered and 24 had participated.

TNA Study

A Training Need Assessment (TNA) was conducted on prospective participants to locate additional areas, besides those listed in the programme schedule.

Methodology

The methodology of the STP has based on achievement of learning outcomes through presentation, activities, reflection and finally evaluation. The guidelines of UGC-HRDC had followed so that STP was interactive and focused.

The 6-days STP has conducted from 18-25 January 2023 through Online Mode.

Brief about the Programme:


