

Regional Centre Itanagar was established in December 2000 to provide access to quality education to the people of the State of





Arunachal Pradesh. During the reporting period, 1178 students were admitted to the various programmes on offer, 114 students were awarded Degree/Diplomas and one PSC was established within the region. Two batches of Mushroom Cultivation Programme were conducted at Mushroom Development Centre, Itanagar as part of the vocational development initiative.

# 6.33 Kohima Regional Centre

Kohima Regional Centre was established on 14th December 2000 to provide educational support to the people of the State of Nagaland. During reporting period 1610 students were admitted and 78 students received their Degree/ Diploma at the 18th convocation. The Regional Centre has managed to acquire 6.7 acres of land on lease for the Regional Centre building. Orientation Programme operators of Community Information Centres (CICs) was organized for running the Computer Literacy Programme. The Regional Centre is also making concerted efforts to collaborate with various departments of the State Government for running some local need based training programmes such as Training Programmes on Watershed Development & Management, Training Programme on Masonry, Training Programme on Mushroom Cultivation and Bamboo Related Crafts.





# 6.34 Shillong Regional Centre


Shillong Regional Centre was established in 1988 for the entire North Eastern States initially but from the year 2001, under the prestigious North East Educational Development Project (NEEDP), IGNOU Regional Centres were established in all the seven sister states of North East including Sikkim. So then on, Shillong Regional Centre was given the responsibility of taking care of the educational requirements of the learners from the State of Meghalaya only. During the Reporting Period 3032 students were admitted, 266 students



received their Degrees/Diploma and one PSC and one SC under the Project mode were established. Eight Admission-cum-Information centres were established. Two Orientation Programmes were organized. There are five Teleconferencing centres and a Gyanvani FM station is going to be created shortly which will function for 3 hours everyday from 5.00 PM to 8.00 PM. The centre is producing programmes in Khasi using local resources for the GyanVani FM Station and the announcements are made in three languages: English, Hindi & Khasi.


# 6.35 Aligarh Sub- Regional Centre

Aligarh Sub Regional Centre was established in 2006 with its jurisdictional area extending



across 14 districts of UP, viz. Jyotibaphule Nagar, Rampur, Aligarh, Budaun, Bareilly, Hathras, Agra, Firozabad, Bijnor Saharanpur, Mathura, Bulandasahar, Muzafarnagar and Moradabad. The enrolment for Jan 2007 was 2,495 for all the programmes on offer.

# 6.36 Madurai Sub- Regional Centre




Madurai Sub-Regional Centre was established in April 2004 with the jurisdictional area extending to 10 districts of Tamil Nadu, viz. Madurai, Dindugul, Pudukkottai, Tirunelveli, Tuticorin, Virudunagar, Ramanthapuram, Sivaganga and Kanyakumari. During the reporting period, 3303 students were Admitted. Translation of the 'Computer Literacy Programme' into Tamil version is in progress. Certificate in Rural Entrepreneurship is the need based programme going to be launched from this region. An orientation programme for Assistant PIC of B.Ed programme was conducted. EDUSAT and other down link facilities are available at seven places within the state. Total revenue collected during the reporting period was Rs.1660902 as against an expenditure of Rs. 450539. Steps have been initiated to build a permanent campus for the SRC at Madurai with a provision for a multimedia learning centre for which the Government of Tamil Nadu has already allotted 40,000 sq.ft land at Madurai.

# 6.37 Rajkot Sub- Regional Centre

Sub-Regional Centre at Rajkot was established in 2004 to look after the activities of IGNOU in the Saurashtra and Kutch region of Gujarat. This region consists of Diu (UT) and 8 districts of Gujarat viz. Rajkot, Kutch, Jamnagar , Porbander, Junagadh, Amreli, Bhavnagar and Surendranagar. This Sub-Regional Centre looks after all academic and administrative activities pertaining to five Regular SCs, six PSCs and 13 Special Study Centres of Saurashtra and Kutch region in





Gujarat. During the reporting period, 3,763 students were admitted.


# 6.38 Siliguri Sub- Regional Centre



Siliguri Sub-Regional Centre was established in 2004 to look after the learner needs in the six districts of North Bengal ( Part of West Bengal). The jurisdiction of the Sub-Regional Centre is entire North Bengal i.e. Coochbehar, Jalpaiguri, Darjeeling, Uttar Dinajpur, Dakshin Dinajpur and Malda. The Sub- Regional Centre looks after all academic and administrative activities in respect of 12 Learner Support Centres of North Bengal which include five Regular Study Centres and ten Special Study Centres.

# 6.39 Varanasi Sub-Regional Centre

Varanasi Sub-Regional Centre came into existence in May 2006 in the premises of BHU campus



with 16 districts of Eastern Uttar Pradesh as its operational area viz: Ambedkar Nagar, Sant Kabir Nagar, Maharajganj, Jaunpur, Ballia, Azamgarh, Gorakhpur, Deoria, Kushinagar, Sant Ravidas Mirzapur, Varanasi, Ghazipur, Mau, Chaundauli, Sonbhadra and Ballia. The Gyan Vani project in the Sub-RC of Varanasi is being run under joint collaboration of IGNOU and BHU and is functional since 18th December, 2004 with three hours of programme transmission from 6.00 A.M. to 9.00 A.M. which has now increased to 8hrs. It has a range of 60 kms. covering mainly Varanasi, Jaunpur, Mirzapur, Chandauli, Sant Ravidas Nagar and Ghazipur and playback facility having 40 kilowatt power c supply has been provided to this Sub Regional Centre. So far 35 in-house audio productions have been transmitted from the Gyan Vani Studio in addition to the recorded programmes received from the EMPC.

# 6.40 Recognised Regional Centres

The University established the Recognised Regional Centres (RRCs) as per MoUs with the Army, Airforce, Navy, BSF, CRPF and Assam Rifles. These are catering to the needs of the members of the military and para military forces and their families. Emphasis has been given on Bachelor Degree Programmes, Computer Training, Disaster Management, MBA programmes, etc. For the reporting period there were 5 IGNOU-Army RRCs, 8 IGNOU-AirForce RRCs, 4 IGNOU-Navy RRCs, 1 IGNOU-Assam Rifles RRC and 7 IGNOU-CRPF RRCs. For the reporting period 3,311 students admitted by these RRCs for various programmes.



# **/** Others

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# 7.1 Distance Education Programme- Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (DEP-SSA)

Indira Gandhi National Open University has been entrusted with the responsibility to implement the Distance Education Programme under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (DEP-SSA) at the National Level by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India. DEP-SSA is responsible for looking into the training needs of elementary school teachers and other SSA functionaries working at different level right form the State headquarter to village level.



The DEP-SSA accomplished various activities approved by MHRD during the year 2006-2007. A brief report on same of the major activities is as under:

#### 7.1.1 National Level Meetings

The DEP-SSA organized National Level meetings for framing policies and guidelines for implementation and review of the programme in the States and at National Level. In the year 2006-2007 DEP-SSA organized one meeting of Advisory Committee, which is an apex body to advise, plan and oversee the implementation of the Programme. Two meetings of Programme Implementation Committee, which is responsible to oversee the implementation of various activities as envisaged in the Annual Action Plan were organized.

Two meetings of Distance Education Coordinators/ In charges were also organized during the year. DECs are the main functionaries at the State level to coordinate between the State and DEP-SSA Headquarter to implement the programme and look after the distance education activities in particular at the state level.

#### 7.1.2 State Resource Group Meeting

DEP-SSA has a provision to constitute SRG in each States under DEP-SSA. The role and function of SRG is to identify training/learning needs for quality elementary education. SRG also ensures sustainability of DE activities



in the State and provide support to State SSA implementation society,

During the year 2006-2007, the SRG meetings were organized in 18 States/UTs to plan, implement and review the DEP activities

#### 7.1.3 National Seminars

During the year 2006-2007, three National Seminars were organized on the theme mentioned below:

- National Seminar on "Innovative Monitoring for Quality Elementary Education Under SSA held during 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2006 to 2<sup>nd</sup> December, 2006 at New Delhi. Total 22 papers were presented during the seminar.
- National Seminar on "Education of Children with Special Needs: An Aspect of Education for All" held during 27<sup>th</sup> December, 2006 to 29<sup>th</sup> December, 2006 at Hyderabad. Total 18 papers were presented during the seminar.
- 3. National Seminar on "Competency based Teaching Learning: A Quality Initiative Under SSA" held during 4th February, 2007 to 6th February, 2007 at Kolkata. Total 19 papers were presented during the seminar.

#### 7.1.8 Miscellaneous

The DEP-SSA remains always busy with organizing meetings, orientation programmes based on the day-to-day functioning of the project. These meetings are initiated by the MHRD according

to the need of the subject and its relevance at the National Level. At the same time, all the issues of immediate nature are taken up and given the final shape to make the project activities more beneficial and effective.

The Project received large number of proposals from the States, which need active involvement of the faculty of DEP-SSA and participation of the functionaries at a large scale. There proposals are always in the interest of educational development and finally to achieve the goal of universalization of Elementary Education and to improve the quality of Education at the elementary level.

The focus remains always on teacher training programmes to produce quality teachers.

#### 7.2 Horticulture Cell

The Horticulture Cell, which functions under a Horticulture Committee, maintains all the green areas at the IGNOU Campus, completed five years in July 2006. During the period April 2006 to March 2007 new areas were developed into gardens in front of the Convention Centre and a terrace garden in the residential complex. Two orchards were also developed with fruit trees. During this period organic farming continued and organic vegetables worth Rs.1.67 lakh were sold to the employees in the current year with the total balance in the IGNOU Plantation Account being Rs.4.56 lakhh (upto March 31, 2007).

About 6000 flowerpots were prepared in the IGNOU Nursery besides multiplication of bushy flowers and trees through cuttings and seeds. More than 3000 trees and bushy plants were planted during the period. Officials of the Forest Department, Southern Range, Delhi visited IGNOU campus and gave a highly appreciative report of tree plantation in IGNOU. The campus gave the look of a valley of flowers at the time of Convocation wherein 54 species of flowers were blooming in the entire campus.

All landscaping was done in-house and the major expenditure areas were expenses on hired labour wages, procurement of good earth and supply of water.

#### 7.3 Public Information Unit

The Public Information Unit (PIU) acts as a bridge between the public and the university. It reaches out to the prospective students of the university by providing information about academic programmes of the university, its instructional system and admission procedures.

During the reporting period, the Unit issued about 150 media releases on the developmental activities of the University. The Unit apprised the media and provided publicity support for various events/ seminars/talks organized by the university, significant among these being the 18<sup>th</sup> Convocation, Seminar on Education and Media, two day seminar in collaboration with Australian High Commission, 11<sup>th</sup> G Ram Reddy Memorial Lecture.

# 7.4 Project Facilitation Unit (PFU)

The unit (formerly known as Project Control Unit) was established to coordinate systematic information flow among the divisions and schools, to mange Management Information System (MIS) and support the Management in Decision Support System (DSS).

The Project Facilitation Unit is responsible for: (a) operationalisation of MIS on academic and administrative activities of the University, (b) collection, compilation and analysis of data bases related to programmes, costs, student performance and student profile, etc; and (c) trend analysis of programmes.

The Unit is also co-ordinates with Schools and Divisions or activities related to programmes and course development, students' registration, printing and dispatch of material and examinations to maintain database and management

information system for policy-decision support. It also responds to all queries from MHRD, UGC, Parliament, PMO and other Government, or non-Government organizations.

# 7.5 Campus Placement Cell

# 7.7 Vigilance Cell

The vigilance Cell of the University is headed by a Chief Vigilance Officer (CVO). This Cell promotes probity and integrity and exercises check and supervision on the vigilance and anti-corruption work. The Cell seeks advise of Central Vigilance Commission, wherever required. The major activities of the Cell are:

- Take preventive vigilance measures in sensitive areas like procurement, award of work and contracts.
- Sensitise University Officers at Headquarters and Regional Centres about



prevention of corruption and improve vigilance administration of the University.

 Investigate into specific complaints of corruption against the personnel of the university.

# 7.8 Committee for Prevention of Sexual Harassment of Women

The Committee for prevention of sexual harassment of women is headed by a senior woman professor. The Committee: (a) bring to the notice of those working in the University and its subordinate offices etc., the definition of sexual harassment as laid down by the Hon. Supreme Court and its express prohibition, (b) take all necessary action to suggest suitable modifications in the Conduct Rules governing the employees to ensure appropriate penalties against the offenders, (c) take all necessary

steps to ensure that appropriate working conditions are provided in respect of work, leisure, health and hygiene and to further ensure that there is no hostile environment towards women at work place and no woman employee has reasonable grounds to believe the she is disadvantaged in connection with her employment, and (d) set up a complaints mechanism to deal with complaints of sexual harassment.

#### 7.9 Creche

The University has a crèche for the children of employees and staff members. It is run by a Society. The University provides financial support and basic infrastructure for it. The crèche provides day care facility and has toys, teaching aids and learning materials for children. During the reporting period 36 children utilized the crèche facility of the University.
