Learning Outcomes

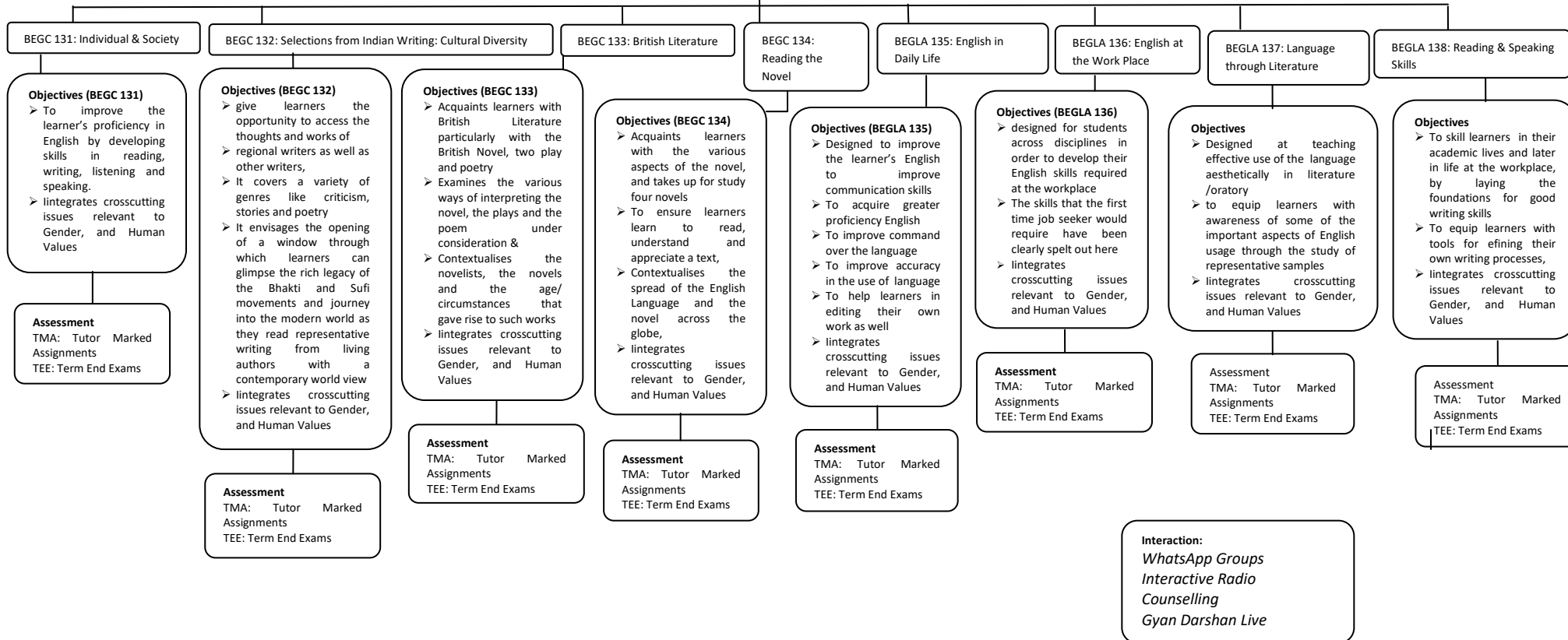
- Students understand different genres, themes and topics in the humanities and social sciences as well as sciences

Programme Structure of the BA Programme

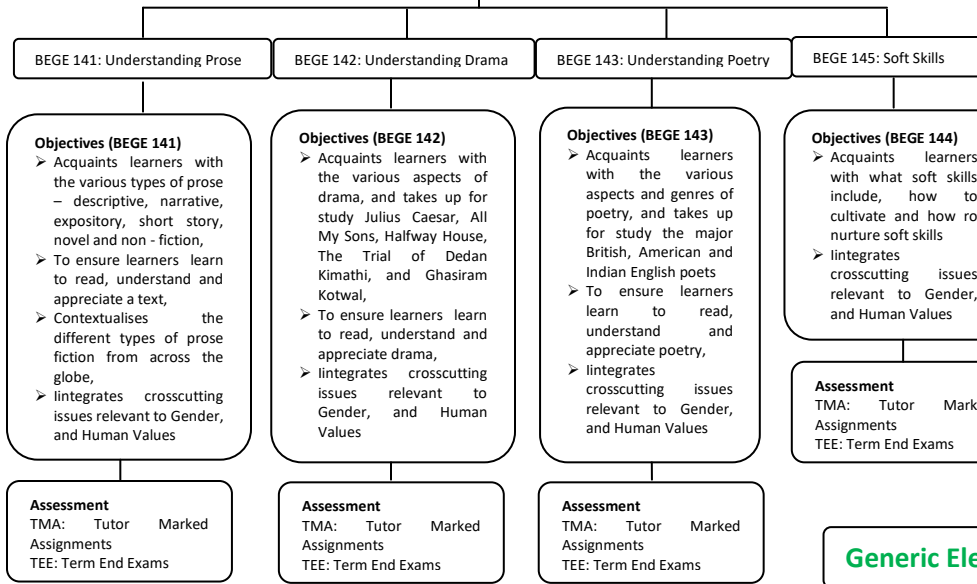
