







10. Do you recommend that the BA/BPA in Theater Arts be offered by SOPVA (IGNOU)?


11. According to you what should be the ideal ratio of theory and practicals in BA/BPA in Theater Arts programme to be offered by IGNOU?








6. According to you what should be medium of instruction? / आपके






