<u>Guidelines for submitting the Proposal for</u> <u>Idea to Startup Scheme for IGNOU Students</u>

In order to promote, support and nurture the innovator students of IGNOU interested in setting up their startups, the University has initiated a scheme of **Idea to Startup** for its students.

Who is Eligible to Participate?

Any *bona fide* student of IGNOU who has developed a prototype or innovative product or system based on new, socially relevant and practicable ideas in the following areas, can submit the detailed startup plan/proposal in the prescribed format available on IGNOU Website.

Why Should You Participate?

If you have any innovative idea in any field which could be converted into a startup, IGNOU will do handling by way of providing all kinds of supports and guidance. In addition to it, the selected best 10 proposals will :

- be provided inclusive training at IGNOU Headquarters at Delhi.
- be provided travelling expenses and stay at IGNOU for a week.
- get opportunity to interact with other innovators and entrepreneurs.
- be facilitated in getting financial support from the funding agencies.
- be provided a national platform to showcase your ideas and startups plans.
