Theme of the Conference

Bharat, more a spirituo-cultural nation than a nation-state, is unique in many aspects. Thousands of years of journey of this great people provides deep insights in the idea of noble statecraft, benevolent governance, individual-society relations, structures, purpose & methodology of education, organic relationship with nature, correlation between spiritual and material life and many more.

Bharat is blessed with perennial flow of eternal wisdom realized and proclaimed from time to time by intellectual giants such as Bharadwaj, Gautam Buddha, Bhagavan Mahavir, Shankaracharya, Nagarjuna, Chanakya, Swami Vivekananda, Maharshi Aravind, Mahatma Gandhi, Dr. Ram Manohar Lohiya and Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya. These great scholars would themselves warn us about following anything or any system blindly. From the past, through the present, to the future is their mantra. Constant churning and refinement of the thought process has been the secret of continuity of Bharatiya thought through times and turbulences. These aspects are not explored enough academically to make them relevant in the present context.

On this background, Bharatiya Shikshan Mandal is organising an International Conference of researchers and intellectuals to unravel various aspects of 'Idea of Bharat'. The conference aims at contributing a new paradigm, an innovative method of improving the existing knowledge and its structures. By taking along the expertise, experience and knowledge of the participants in this conference, better alternatives to the existing system of knowledge could be built. This conference, like the earlier conferences of the Shikshan Mandal would be an epoch making exercise in this spirit.

Objectives of the Conference

- (i) To rekindle the eternal basic postulates that constitutes Bharat.
- (ii) To revisit the fundamentals with applied approach in the present context.
- (iii) To encourage evolving of Bharatiya paradigm of understanding and analysing phenomena- social, scientific, legal, commercial etc. through quality research.
- (iv) To invite a variety of well researched approaches towards the Idea of Bharat from all over the world.

संगोष्ठी की भूमिका (मंत्र)

भारत मूलतः एक सांस्कृतिक व आध्यात्मिक राष्ट्र है। केवल राजकीय राष्ट्र राज्य नहीं। हमारी हजारों वर्षों की यात्रा ने इस देश के जनमानस में एक गहरी अंतर्दृष्टि विकसित की है। जो सभ्यसमाज, कल्याणकारी राज्य, व्यक्ति व समाज के अंतर्संबंध, संरचनायें, शिक्षा का उद्देश व पद्धति, प्रकृति के साथ मानव के एकात्मसंबंध तथा भौतिक व आध्यात्मिक जीवन के अंतर्संबंध ऐसे कई स्वरूपों में अभिव्यक्त होती है।

युगों युगों से इस देश की मनीषा ने समय-समय पर सत्य का साक्षात्कार कर उसका बार-बार उद्घोष किया है। महर्षि भारद्वाज, गौतम बुद्ध, भगवान महावीर, शंकराचार्य, नागार्जुन, चाणक्य, स्वामी विवेकानंद, महर्षि अरविंद, महात्मा गांधी, डॉ. राममनोहर लोहिया तथा पं. दीनदयाल उपाध्याय प्रभृति महापुरुषों की प्रतिभा के शाश्वत प्रवाह से यह भारत भू सर्वदा अभिव्यक्त होती रही है। इन महापुरुषों ने स्वयं हमें किसी भी तथ्य के और किसी भी तंत्र के अधानुकरण से बचने के लिए हमेशा से सचेत किया है। अतीत से सीखते हुए, वर्तमान में केन्द्रित हो भविष्य की ओर दृष्टि रखना यह ऋषी परंपरा का दिया हुआ मंत्र है।

सतत तत्व चिंतन तथा विचार पद्धति के निरंतर परिशोधन से काल के कराल थपेड़ों में सर्वदा भारतीयता का यह प्रवाह अक्षुण्ण व अबाधित रहा है। बौद्धिक जगत ने वर्तमान संदर्भों में यद्यपि इन सभी आयामों को युगानुकूल बनाने के प्रयास तो किया है परंतु इस दिशा में अभी और गंभीर प्रयत्नों की अपेक्षा है। इसी परिदृश्य में भारतीय शिक्षण मण्डल अनुसंधानकर्ताओं तथा शोधकर्ताओं की यह अन्तर्राष्ट्रीय संगोष्ठी आयोजित कर रहा है जो भारत-बोध के विभिन्न आयामों को अनावृत करेगी। इस संगोष्ठी का उद्देश्य नये संदर्भ विकसित करने में योगदान, उपलब्ध ज्ञान तथा संरचना को नित्यनूतन पद्धतियों से विकसित करना, सहभागी विशेषज्ञों के अनुभवों ज्ञान तथा विशिष्टताओं को साझा करते हुए वर्तमान में उपलब्ध ज्ञान के ओर अधिक पुष्ट बनाकर पर्यायी तंत्र का निर्माण करना है।

भारतीय शिक्षण मण्डल द्वारा पूर्व में आयोजित संगोष्ठीयों के समान यह संगोष्ठी भी इस दिशा में युगान्तरकारी प्रयासों का शंखनाद करेगी।

संगोष्ठी के उद्देश्य

- 1) भारत का निर्माण करने वाले शाश्वत सिद्धांतों को पुनर्दीप्त करना।
- 2) तत्व को वर्तमान परिप्रेक्ष्य में लागू करने की दृष्टि से प्रस्तुत करना।
- 3) तर्क तथा समझ दोनों ही दृष्टि से विभिन्न क्षेत्रों जैसे सामाजिक, वैज्ञानिक, विधिक तथा व्यापारिक आदि में गुणात्मक अनुसंधान की गहरी भारतीय अंतर्दृष्टि विकसित करना।
- 4) भारत-बोध जागृत करने हेतु सम्पूर्ण विश्व से गहन अनुसंधान आधारित दृष्टिकोण को आमंत्रित करना।

About New Delhi

New Delhi is the capital of Bharat. Delhi had served as the political and financial centre of several empires of ancient Bharat in Mahabharata era. It was the capital of Pandavas, called as Indraprastha - "City of the God Indra". The Iron Pillar, symbol of victory of Chandra Gupta situated in Qutub complex, is a 7 m (23 ft) column, notable for the rust-resistant composition of the metals used in its construction. India Gate is a war memorial located astride the Rajpath, dedicated to 82,000 soldiers who died in the First World War.

Climate of Delhi during the period of conference will be pleasant but may turn cold at night. So you are requested to bring warm clothes.
