

### 7.1.8 REPORT ON IGNOU INITIATIVES TO PROMOTE INCLUSIVENESS

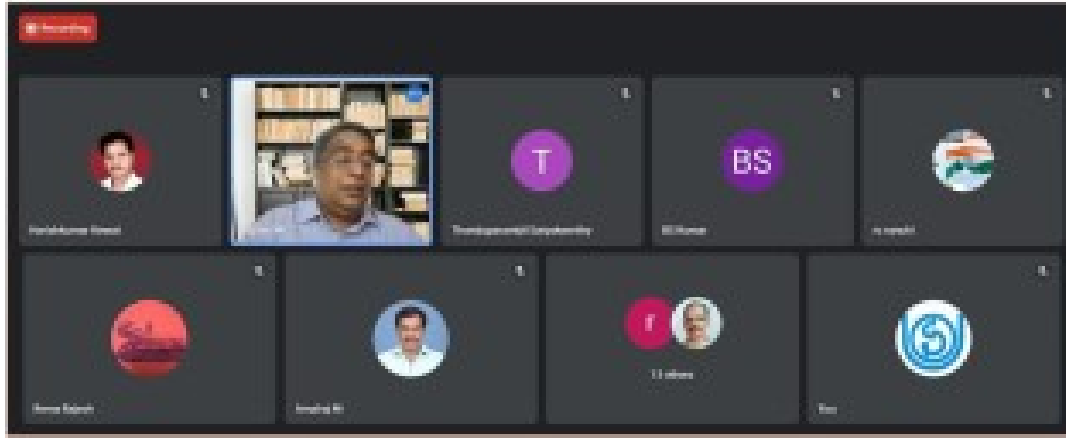

Prof. Nageshwar Rao, VC IGNOU flagged off the All Women Bike Rally at IGNOU Headquarters .



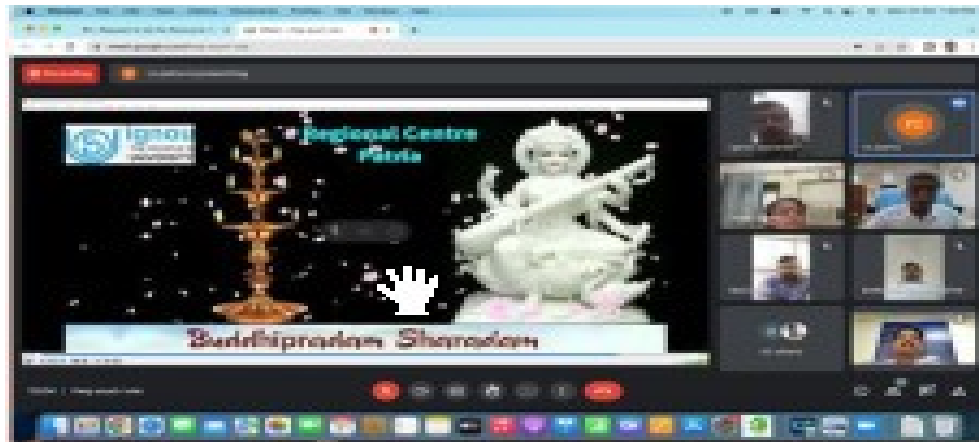
The RC Khanna organized Swachhata Pakhwada under which Swachhata Pledge was taken by the staff and officials of the RC
