Monthly Monitoring Report for the month of APRIL 2023

The Regional Services Division (RSD) regularly monitors the activities undertaken by the 57 Regional Centres. The RCs undertake various routine activities throughout the year such as promotional-publicity, admissions, examinations, strengthening of learner support centers, monitoring of learner support centers, conduct of academic counselling sessions and induction meetings. RSD obtains monthly data of all the above stated activities from Regional Centers and compiles them as monthly monitoring reports. In addition, the academics of the RC participate in different research and professional development activities which are also collected and compiled in the MMR.

In the last one-two years, the University has transitioned from the ODL to Online mode of programme delivery for which learner support is provided through a wide range of electronic media and digital platforms by the RCs. Further various schemes of the GOI are implemented by the RCs which are UBA, SBA, EBSB, AKAM, HGT etc. In view of this, the MONTHLY MONITORING REPORT format has been modified from APRIL 2023 in line with new activities including the requirement of NAAC matrices which have been shared by CIQA.

Report on activities: Regional Centers ask to share reports of activity/events like Promotional, Induction, Coordinator meetings, Orientation Programme, Seminar, Extension outreach programme, UBA, ECP, innovation etc with GEOTAG pictures in MS Word format.

The Monthly Monitoring Report (MMR) for the month of **APRIL 2023** has been compiled by the RSD. The MMR has been presented under various subheadings outlining the Academic Activities of Regional Centers and Learner Support Centers. Further, various Finance & Accounts related matters, i.e., expenditures incurred by Regional Centers and Learner Support Centers have been analyzed. The major components of analysis outlined in the reports have been mentioned below:

- 1.) Promotional & Publicity Drives of Regional Centers:** The analysis includes Digital promotional initiatives/activities like use of digital platforms to enhance outreach. Other analyses include the number of press / media publicity releases. Further, the analysis includes meetings/orientation programs through digital platforms for LSC functionaries.
- 2.) Meetings, Trainings & Orientation Programme at Regional Centre:** The section includes monitoring of counselling sessions held at Learner Support Centers and other activities of LSCs like induction meetings, grievance redressal and number of scanned copies of assignments received and evaluated at LSCs.
- 3.) Strengthen of LSCs & ECs:** This part consists of the number of student queries handled and utilization of SMS for communication with students.

- 4.) **Monitoring of Study Centres Activities:** This point of analysis encompassed Faculty Development Programme, Webinar/Seminar organized/participated, Radio/TV program etc.
- 5.) **Student Support Activities:** The expenditure incurred for operations of Regional Centers and Learner Support Centers have been analyzed. For the Regional Centre, the points of analysis included Regular Staff Salary, Daily Wage payment, Security, Building Rent, Travel and hiring of taxi, Printing/Publicity, Meeting/workshop/Orientation Programme etc. For the Learner Support Centers, the expenditure was analyzed on the basis of Salary of Part Time functionaries and Counseling, Assignment Evaluation, Practical's etc
- 6.) **Academic Activities by Academics at Regional Centre:** In this section details about the use of various digital and social media by the Regional Centers are included.
- 7.) Accounts & Finance
- 8.) Staff Strength
- 9.) Use of social media
- 10.) In addition to the above sections, brief reports on the various events that were held during reporting month were included in the "Other Events" section of MMR.

Executive Summary

MMR APRIL 2023 – Executive Summary

The analysis for MMR APRIL 2023 is completely based on the data provided by the Regional Centres. As per the practice, the data for the Monthly Monitoring Report (MMR) was received through a filled-in format as well as through the Google Form. Both were received online. The MMR format which was in used earlier has been modified from APRIL 2023. Some new features have been included in the MMR format.

The data received from 57 Regional Centres have been analysed in this Executive Summary for MMR- APRIL 2023. The analysis has been done under various subheadings for Promotional, extension and outreach activities of the Regional Centres, and Learner Support Centres. Further, various Finance & Accounts related matters, i.e., expenditures incurred by Regional Centres and Learner Support Centres have been analysed. Information related to academic and professional development of the academics of the regional centres has been also compiled and analysed. Immediately following the Executive Summary, data tables pertaining to various activities have been provided. Thereafter, a brief summary of the events held across the country has been provided along with the pictures of those programs.

Promotional, Extension and Outreach Activities

During the month of APRIL 2023, Regional Centres organized various promotional and publicity activities. During this time general publicity initiative/activities to enhance outreach, programme specific publicities, efforts for reaching out to the persons who do not have access to higher education like disadvantaged communities e.g., PH, SC/ST, Women etc.

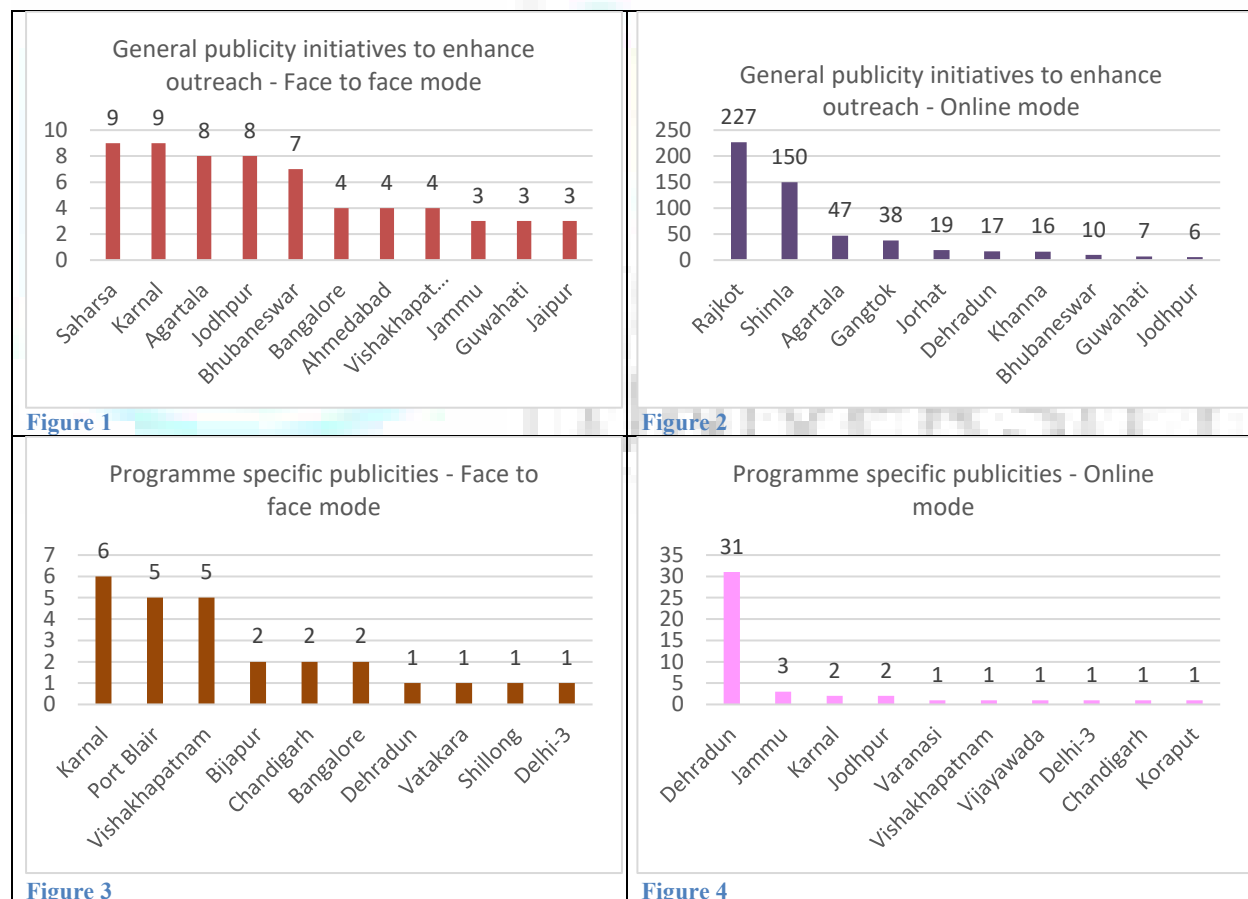
Summary of general and specific publicity and promotional activities carried out in face to face mode and online mode has been given in table 1. A total of 720 such activities have been undertaken across all 57 Regional Centres. The list of top ten regional centers in terms of general publicity initiative/activities (f2f mode), general publicity initiative/activities (online mode), specific publicities (f2f mode), specific publicities (online mode) has been given in figure 1 to 4.

RC wise general and specific publicity and promotional derives carried out in online mode as well as face to face have been given from table 14 and 15. Summary of total number such activities has been given in table 1. Figures 1 to 4 show the top ten regional centres, who have organised highest number of promotional and publicity activity in online and face to face mode.

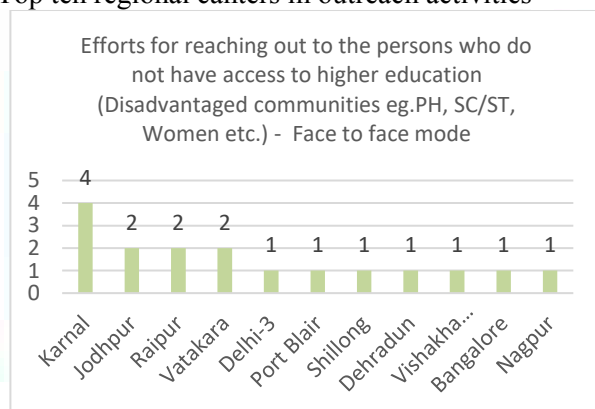

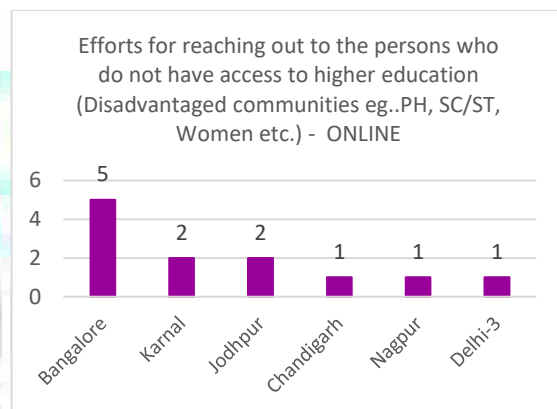

In addition, extension activities for sensitizing learners and other stakeholders to social and sustainable development issues leading to an inclusive society, as well as extension and outreach programs carried out by the regional centers in collaboration both in online and face-to-face modes, were also considered in the MMR for APRIL 2023. Top ten regional centers organised higher no. of extension activities

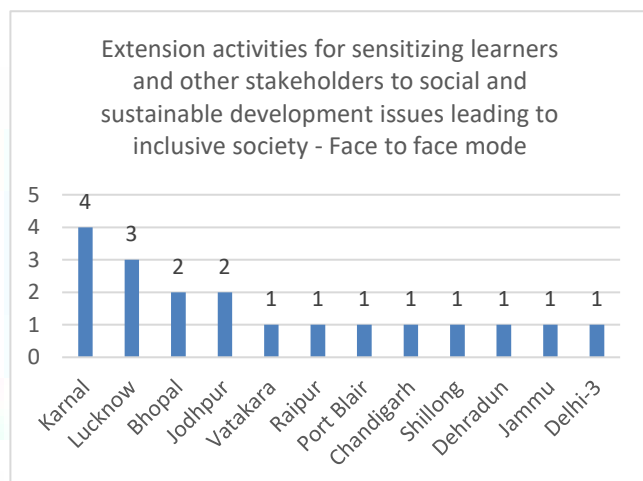

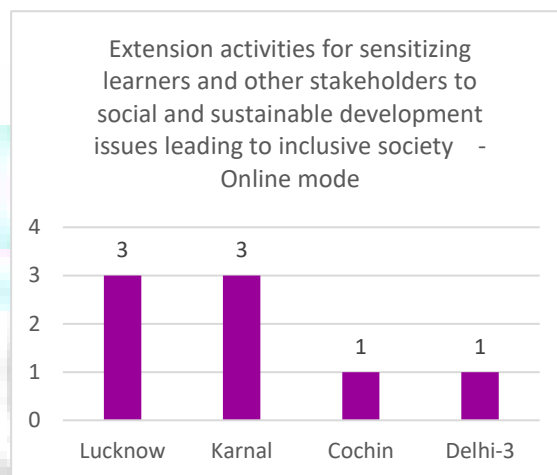

List of top ten Regional Centres are given in figure 9. A total of 228 press releases/media coverages were reported during APRIL 2023 across the Regional Centres (Table 20).

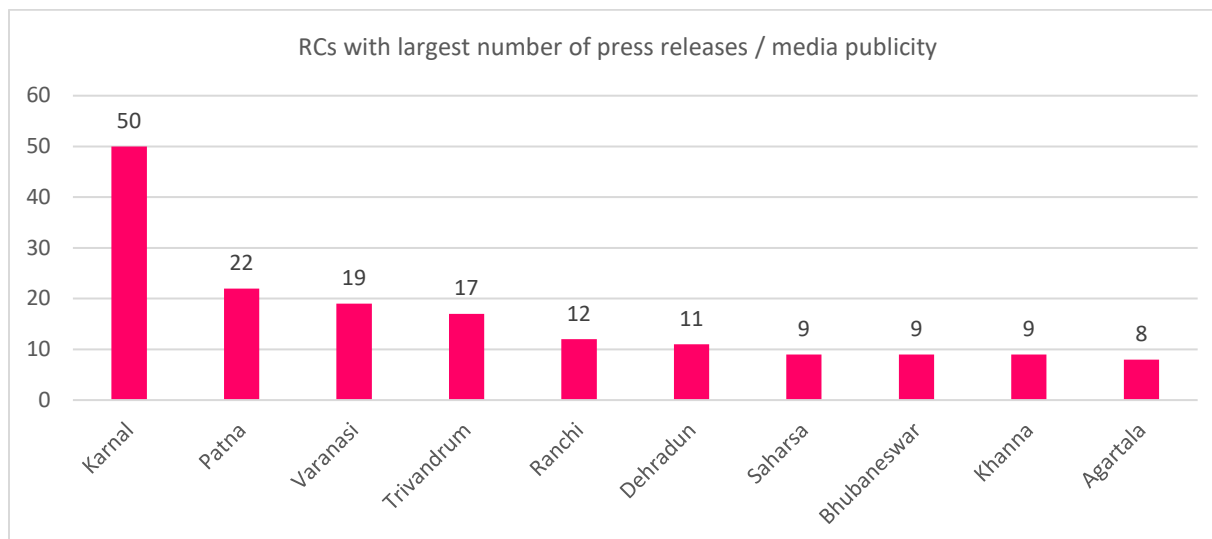

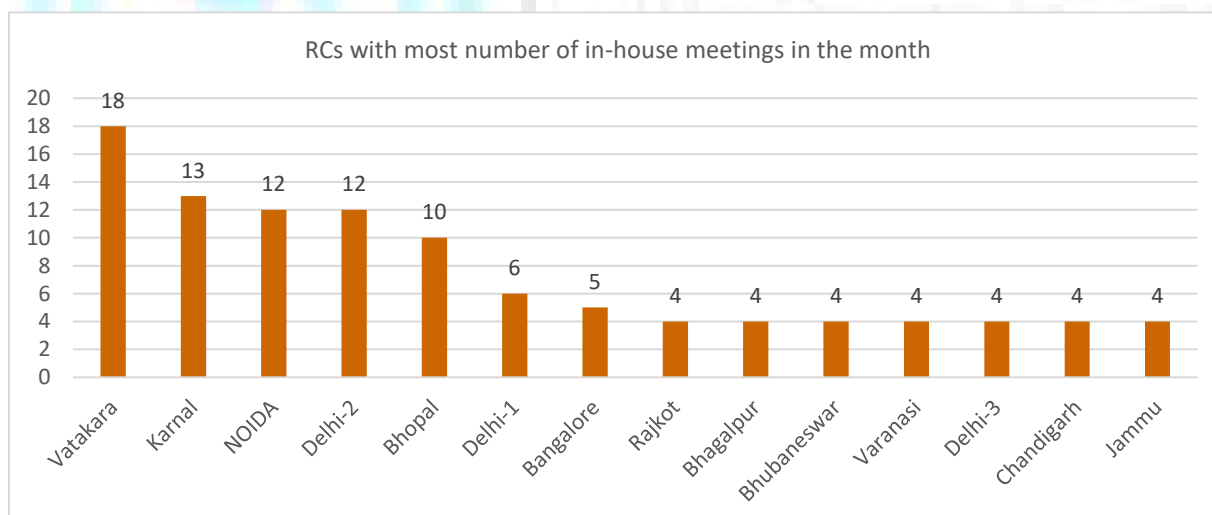

Capacity building and the orientation of part-time functionaries appointed in the learner support centers (LSC) are some of the key activities of regional centres. During the month of APRIL 2023, a total of 65 such activities were undertaken across the regional centres (Table 23 and 24). This category involves meetings and orientation of coordinators and PICs of study centers, training of other part-time functionaries, orientation of academic counsellors and a new item which has been

included in the MMR from January 2023 is the training programme organized by regional centers for handling of Learning Management System (LMS). The training on LMS were organised by regional centers Bijapur, Chandigarh, Dehradun, Delhi-2, Hyderabad, Raipur, Shillong. List of top ten regional centres who organised the highest number of such activities is given in figure 11.

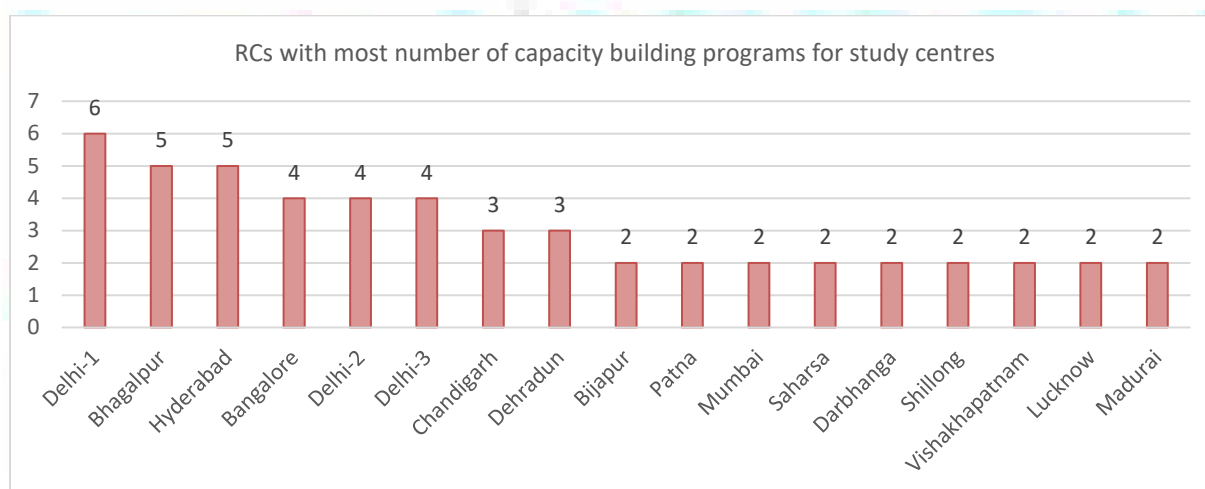

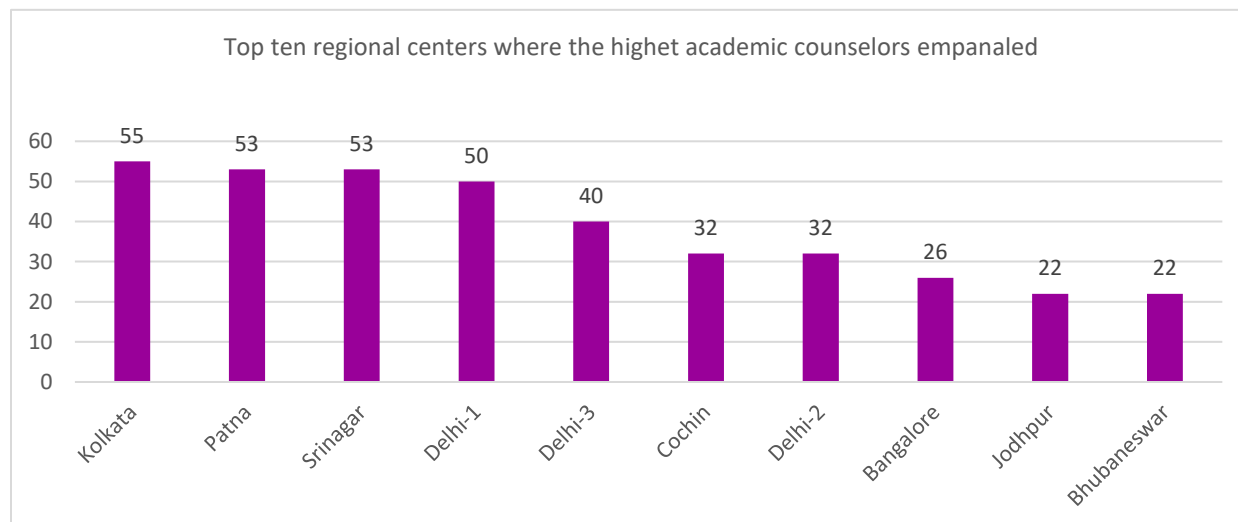

Regional Centres and Learners Support Centres Activities

Induction meeting (IM) is an important event in IGNOU which is held at the Learner Support Centres (LSC) for newly enrolled students. The goal of this meeting is to familiarize newly admitted students with the open and distance learning system and the way it functions.

During the Corona pandemic, the Learner Support Centres organized this activity virtually. Since all COVID-19 restrictions and prohibitions have been lifted across the country. Face to face and physical activities have been restored to normalcy in the institutions and colleges. Accordingly, some of the LSCs also conducted the IM in face-to-face mode. In addition, induction meetings

were also organized separately for the students who had enrolled in an online academic programme. Regional centre-wise details of IM has been given in table 27.

A total 232 induction meetings (IM) were organised during the APRIL 2023 (Table 7), whereas total 119 number of inductions meetings organized in online mode for ODL Programme. The top ten regional centres in terms of holding IM for ODL programme through online mode has been given in figure 13. Figure 14 shows the top twelve regional centres holding IM in face to face mode for ODL programme. A total of 55 IM was organized for students of the ODL program in face to face mode during APRIL 2023 in online as well as face to face mode. The university offers academic programme in two different modes – ONLINE mode and Offline (ODL mode). Hence, the Regional Centres were also asked to provide data for the IM organised for the students enrolled in online programme. The regional centers were organised 58 induction meetings for online academic programme. List of top eleven regional centres who have organised the largest number of IM for the students of online programme has been given in figure 15.

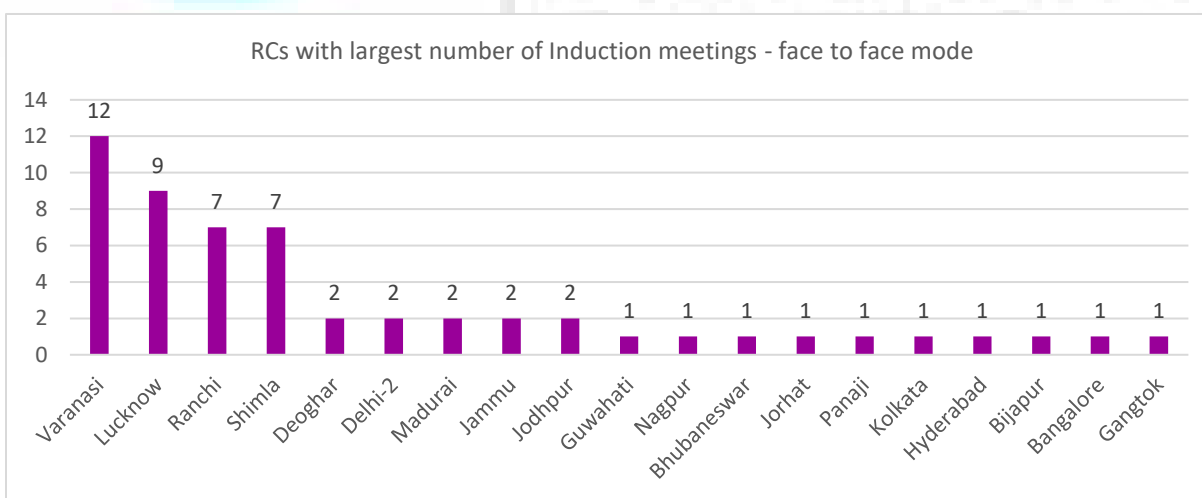

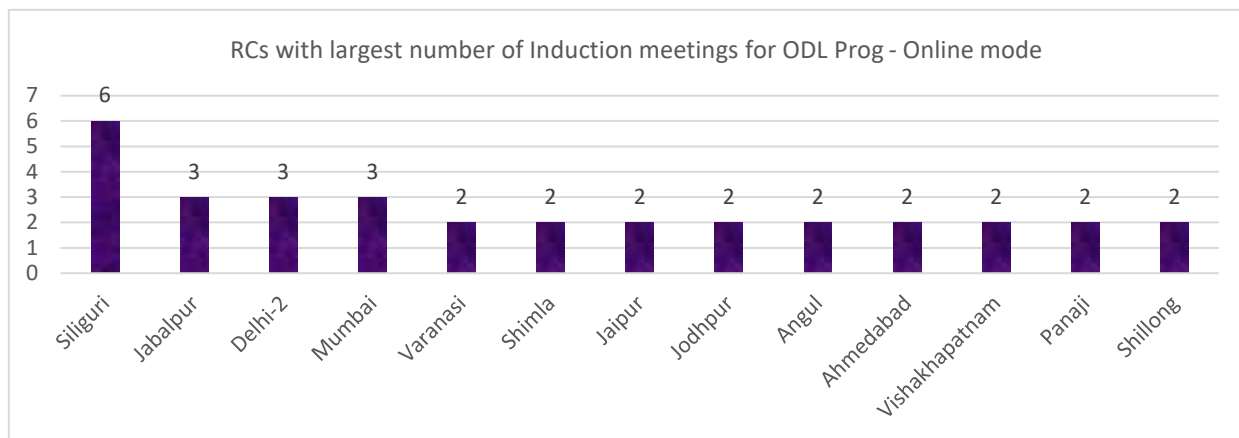

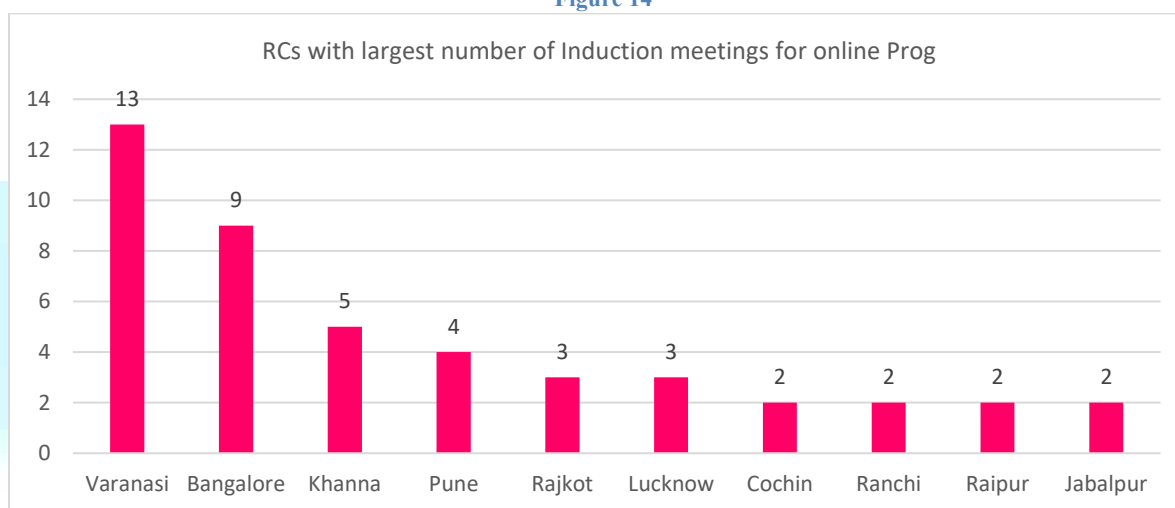

Academic Counselling sessions - The number of academic counselling sessions organised for theory courses for the Open and Distance Learning (ODL) programme in online and face-to-face modes; number of academic counselling sessions organised for practical courses for the ODL program; and the number of academic counselling sessions organised for the online programme are the items that have been taken into consideration separately. As far as the number of academic counselling sessions is concerned, a total 15604 such sessions were organised across the regional centres in the month of APRIL 2023. Item-wise summary of academic counselling sessions held across the country has been given in Table 8. RC wise details of academic counselling sessions

organised for ODL Prog (Online and f2f mode), Practical courses for ODL Prog and academic counselling for Online programme have been given in table 28.

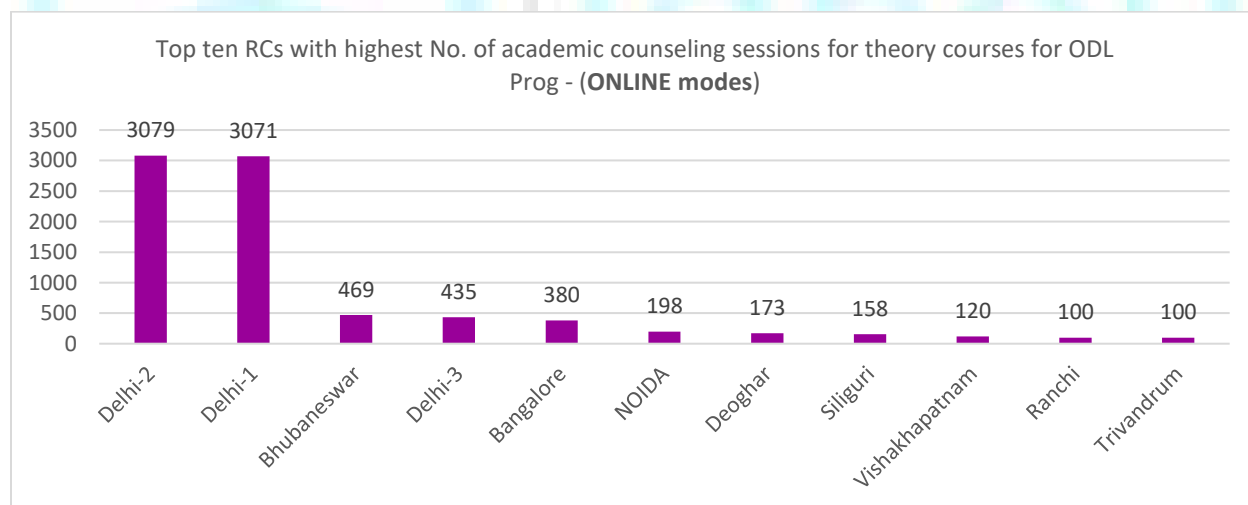

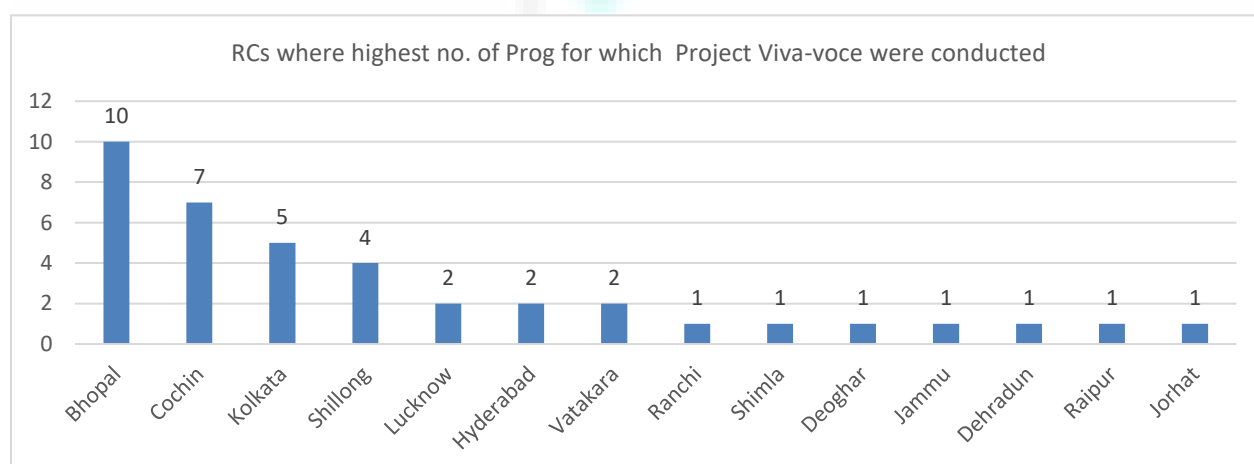

Assignments - The status of evaluation assignments is another item that has been assessed under - number of assignments received by RCs/LSCs, and number of assignment awards transmitted to Hqrs for the ODL programme and online programme during the reporting month. Regional centres have provided information related to assignments received by RCs/LSCs for ODL programme in both offline and online mode separately. Separate data was collected for awards sent by regional centres to the SED as well as assignments received at RCs/LSCs. A separate section has been also created in the MMR format to obtain the status of assignments for the Online Programme. 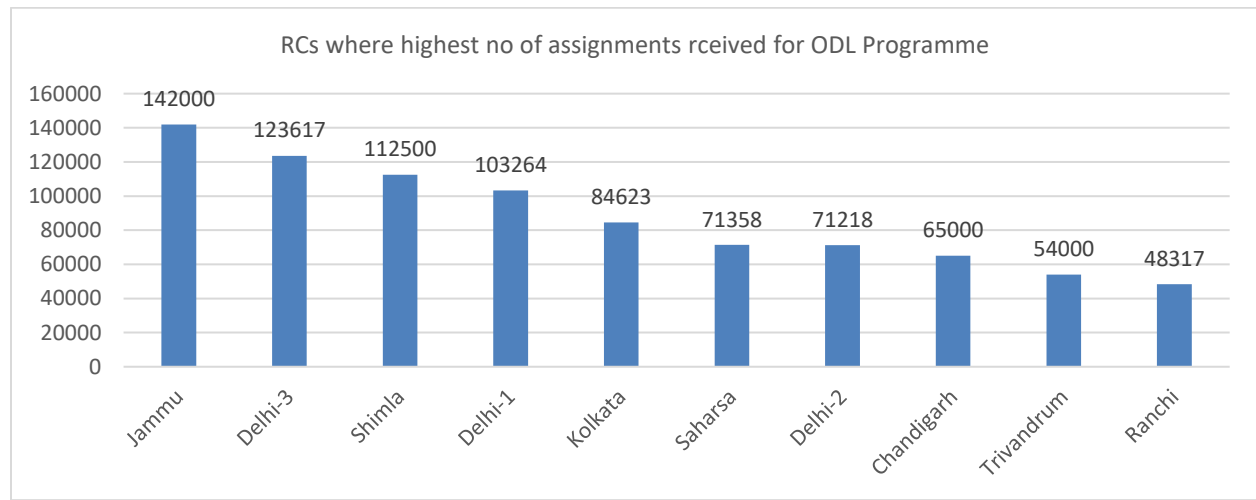

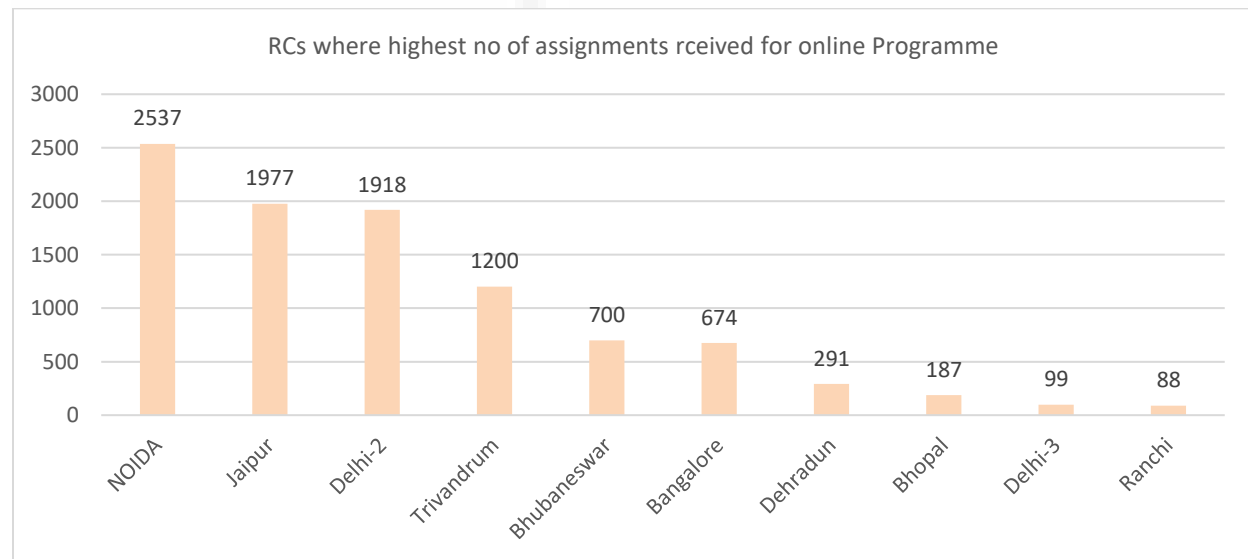

Monitoring of Study Centres Activities

Monitoring Activities by RCs - Monitoring of functioning of Study Centres is one of the important activities of Regional Centres. Monitoring of academic counselling sessions is an important component of this category. The participation of RCs in the induction meeting (IM) is very important part, as academics from the RCs address the new learners during the induction meeting. In the reporting month, a total 155 IM were addressed and attended by the academics of the regional centres, which is 66.81% of the total IM (232) organised across the regional centers (Table 7). Top thirteen regional centers where the highest number of academics were attended IM have been given in figure 23 and 24. Regional centers-wise status of induction meetings attended, academic counselling sessions visited, visit of exam and entrance exam centers has been provided in table 33 to 36. Data of monitoring of academic activities of the study centers has been summarised in table 11.

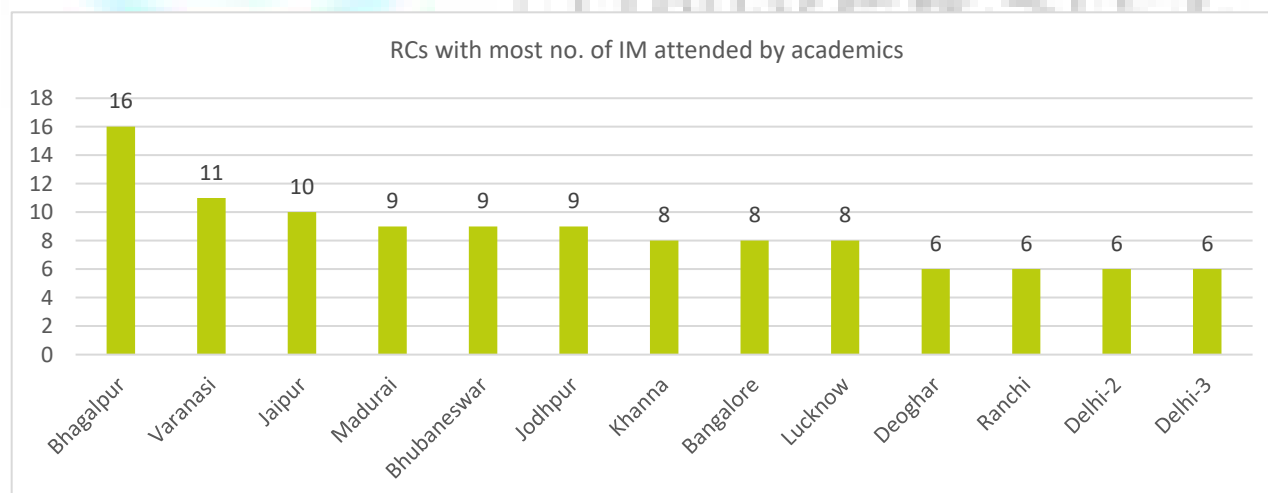

In the month of APRIL 2023, out of total 15604 academic counselling sessions organised (Table 8), 607 no. of academic counselling sessions were monitored by the academics of the regional

centres, which 3.89% of the total academic counselling sessions monitored (Table 11). Top-ten Regional Centres where the largest number of academic counselling sessions were monitored have been given in figure 24. Regional centers wise number of sessions monitored has been given in the table 33.

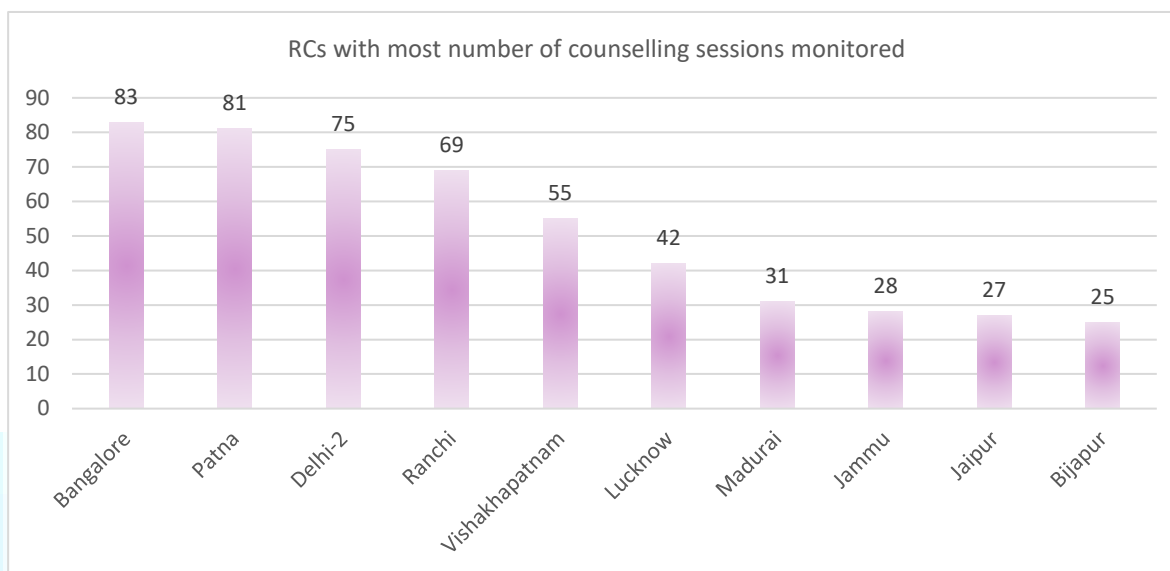

Regional centers officials' actively involve in monitoring of term end exams (theory and practical both) and entrance examination related activities in their respective regions. During the period of report, a total 18 such exam centres monitoring activities were carried out by the officials of RCs.

Student Support Services

Resolving students queries by regional centres (table 37 and 38), use of SMS to communicate with the students (table 39) and holding grievance redressal camps/sessions to interact with the student (table 40) are the parameters which have been analysed in this part of the report. Handling of student queries and grievances are crucial for effective student support services. All regional centres answer students' issues face-to-face in person as well as via email, telephone, post,

Facebook, and other means (table 37). Table 38 shows the RC wise information regarding handling of total number of students' queries at each regional centers in the month of APRIL 2023. Across all Regional Centres, a total of 243432 queries were handled. The list of top-ten regional centres who attended maximum number of students' queries has been shown in figure 25. These ten regional centres handled 47.73% of the total number of queries received at all regional centres.

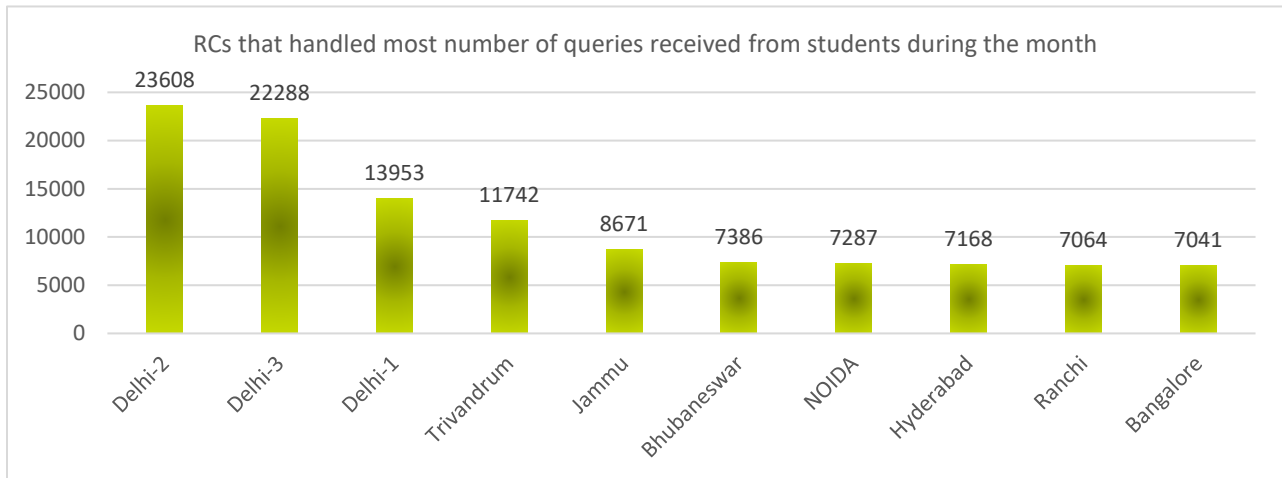

Use of SMS is an important mode of communication for the regional centres. It is used to communicate important messages to the learners urgently. For this purpose, Regional Centres use the bulk SMS facilities. During the month of APRIL 2023, a total of 289827 SMS was sent to the students to communicate various types of information to the learners (table 39). Figure 26 lists the regional centres that have used the SMS service the most frequently during the month.

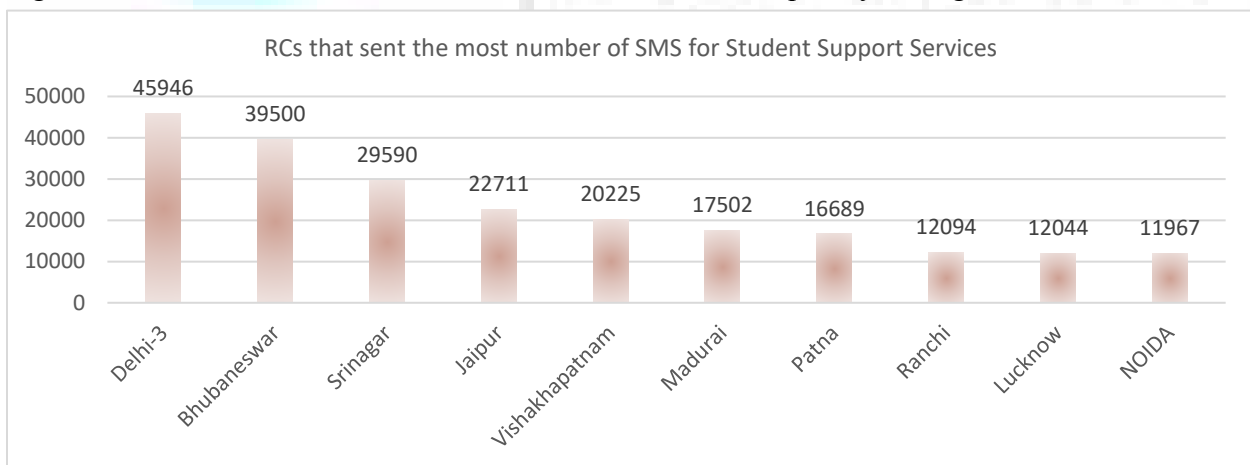

Receiving and resolving student grievances is a crucial part of student support services. During the month, regional centres organized online and face to face mode (offline) grievance redressal camps to address students queries and problems related to their studies. In the month of APRIL 2023, all together 107 such camps were held by the regional centres (Table 40). Out of 107, 48 have been organised in face to face mode and 59 virtual sessions had been hold by the regional centres to resolve students’ grievances. 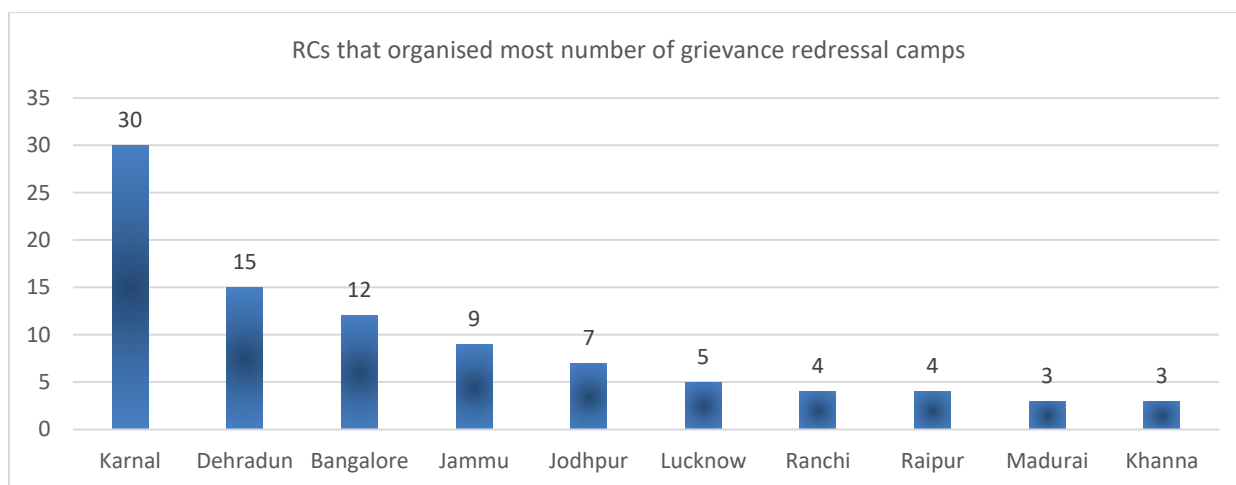

Research and Academic Development Activities

Regional Centre wise Research and Academic Development activities have been given in Table 40. During the month of APRIL, 2023, Regional Centres reported a total of 114 different Research and Academic Development activities including Faculty Development Programme, Webinar/Seminar organized/participated, Radio/TV program and so on (table 41). Indeed, the top ten regional centres (figure 28) reported a total 81 such activities accounting for 71.05% of the total during APRIL 2023.

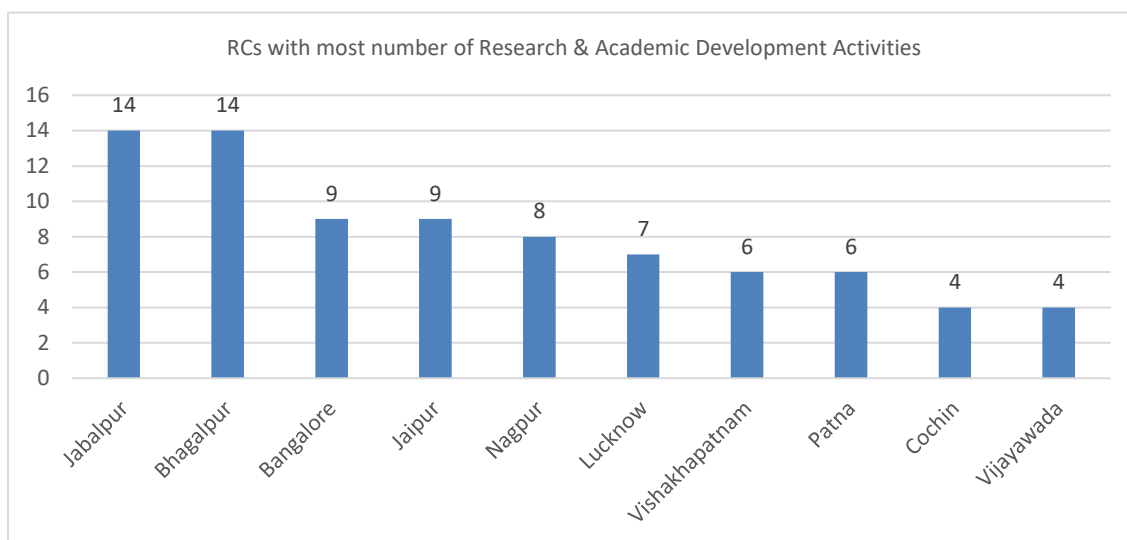

Expenditure of Regional Centres

This section of the report deals with the expenses of Regional Centres incurred to meet the functioning of Regional Centres during APRIL 2023. The analysis includes the Regional Centre wise total expenditure as well as item-wise expenditures during APRIL 2023. The data is provided in Table 42 to 53. In APRIL 2023, a total expenditure of Rs. 174010117/- was incurred across the regional centres (table 42). Figure 29 shows the names of the top-ten regional centres that accounted for about 47.36% of total expenditure incurred across all the regional centres. Regional centre Raghunathganj and Aligarh reported zero expenses (Figure 30). RC **Chennai** and RC **Imphal** did not send MMR for the month of APRIL 2023 till 21.04.2023, the day when the MMR data was downloaded and processed.

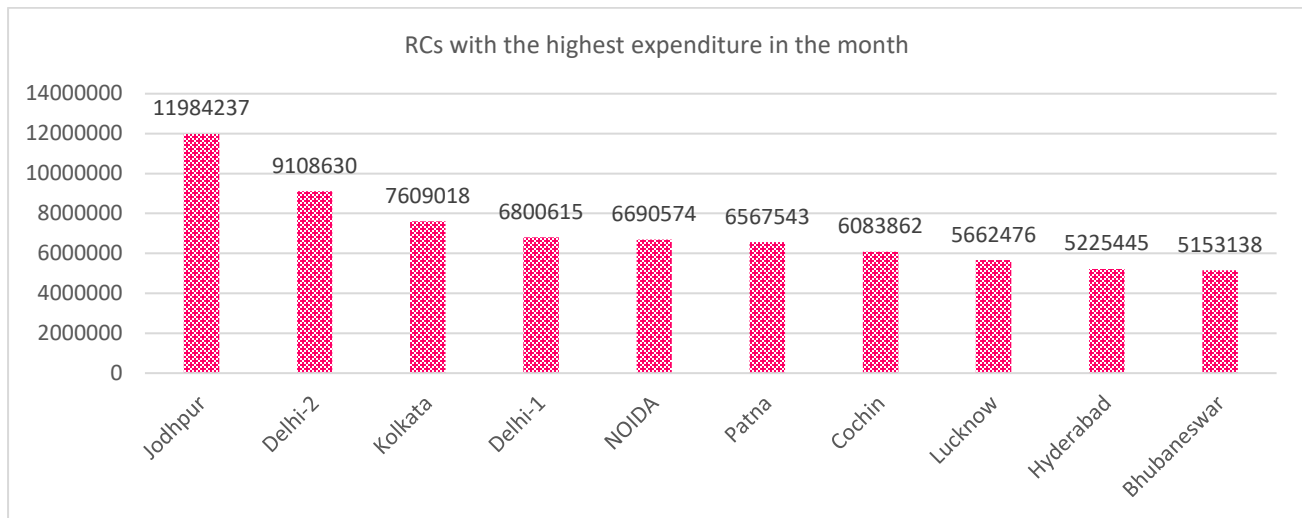

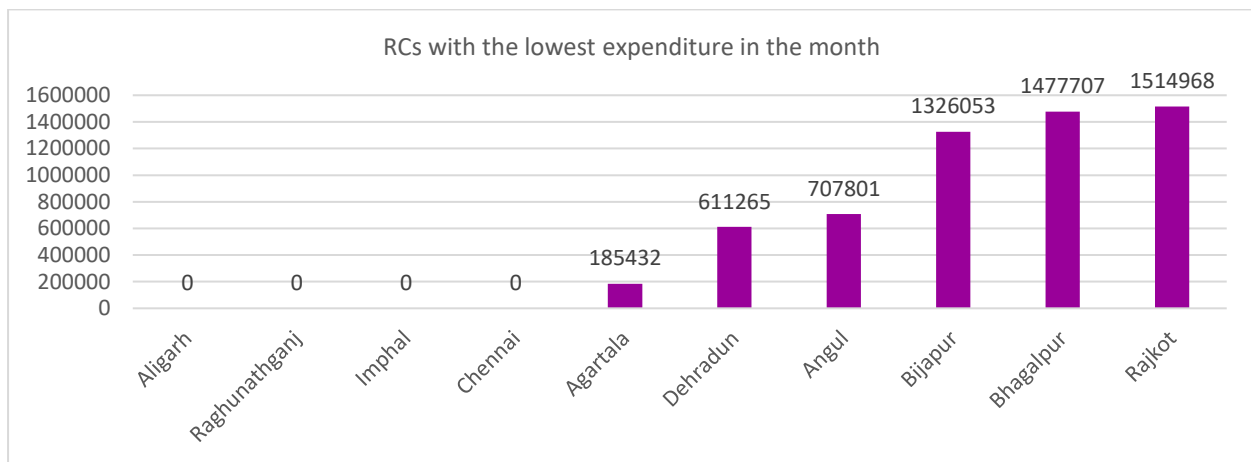

Table 42 shows the expenditure incurred on the payment of **salaries to regular staff** of the regional centres. Percentage of expenditure incurred on the payment of staff salaries at respective regional centres has been given in the corresponding column of the table 43. Top-ten regional centres that had the highest expenditure for paying staff salaries are given in figure 31. Across all regional centres, a total of Rs. 119143388/- was spent for the payment of staff salaries which accounted for 68.46% of total expenditure (Rs. 174010117/-) of the regional centres.

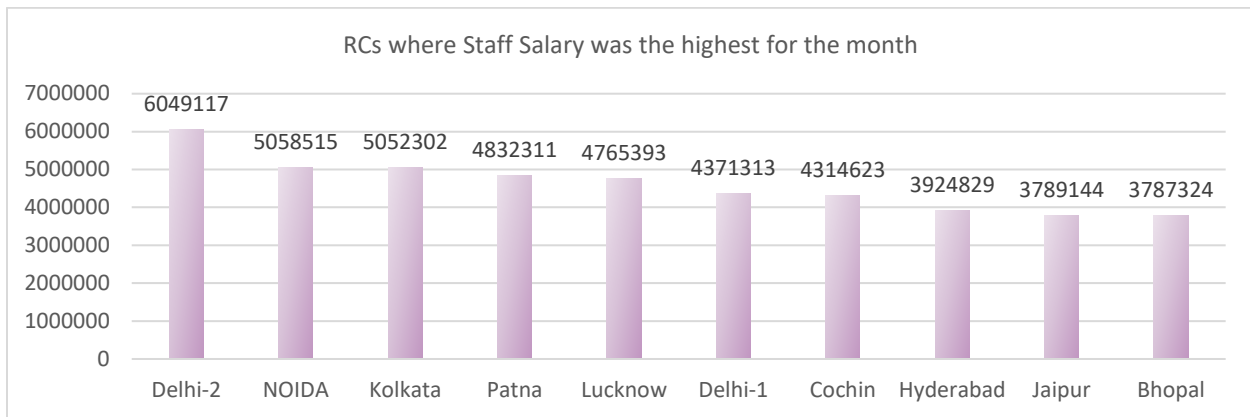

Payment towards the salaries of **daily wager** staff working at the Regional Centres is the next item which has been analysed. Regional Centre wise data on the payment of daily wagers' salaries has been given in Table 44. A total of Rs. 7298753/- has been paid towards the salaries of daily wagers across the Regional Centres which was 4.19% of the total expenditure of Rs. 174010117/. 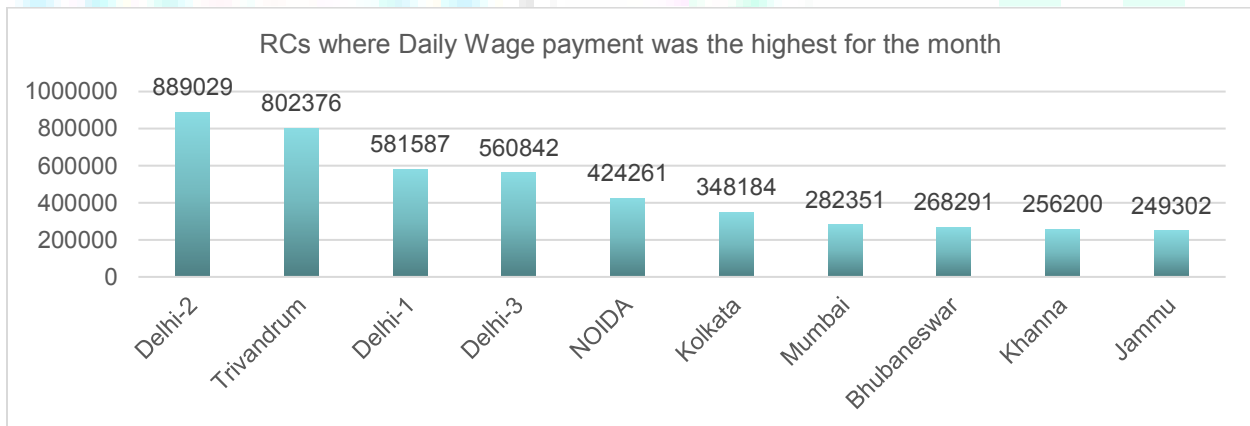

Expenditure for the arrangement of **security** is another item of expense at the Regional Centres. Regional Centre wise expenditure under this head has been given in table 45. It shows that a sum of Rs. 1913336/- was spent by all the Regional Centers, which accounted for 1.1% of total expenditure (Rs. 174010117/-) of all Regional Centers. Under this category, the top-ten Regional Centers who spent the highest amount of their total expenditure on security arrangements have been given in figure 33. There were 33 regional centers that reported nil expenses for security arrangements (table 45).

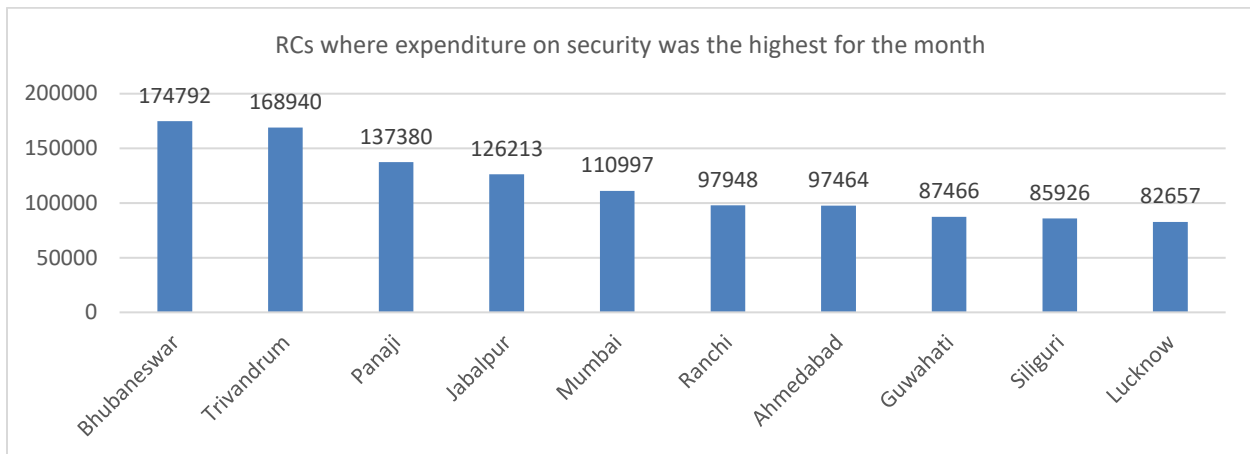

There are Regional Centres which are operational in **rented building**. Regional Centre wise expenses towards the rent of hiring buildings are given in table 46. Analysis of data indicates that a sum of Rs. 2769039/- was spent for paying the rent of buildings by the regional centers, which accounted for 1.59% of total expenditure (Rs. 174010117/-) on regional centres functioning. 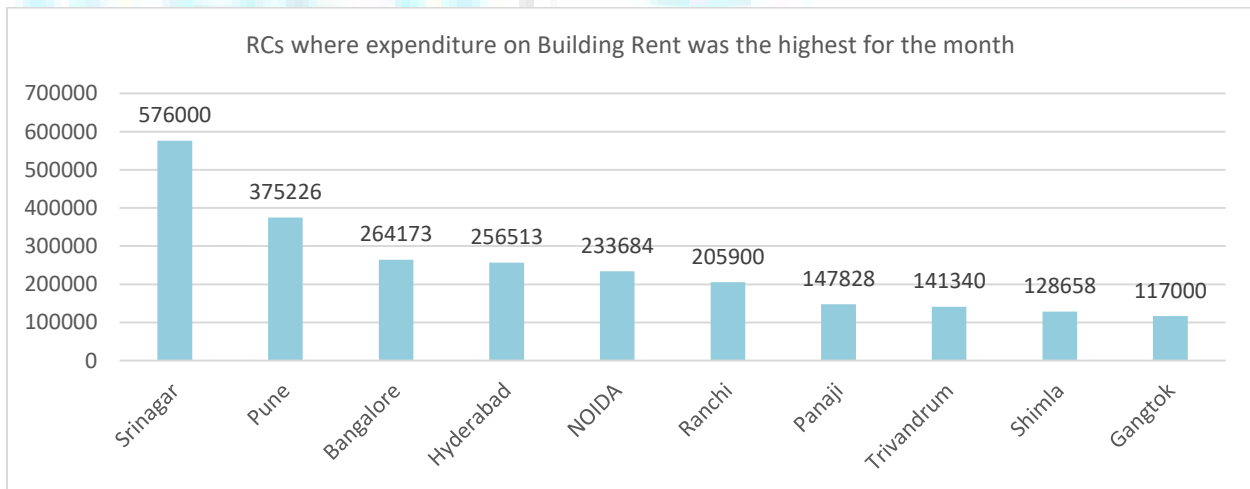

Expenses on **tours and travel**, and hiring taxis are other items of expenditures of regional centres. In this regard, regional centre wise expenditure incurred during APRIL 2023 is given in table 47. It shows that Rs. 290045/- was spent to meet the expenses of tours and travels at all the regional centres, which was mere 0.17% of the total expenditure of Rs. 174010117/- wherein 36 regional centres reported nil expenditure for this item. 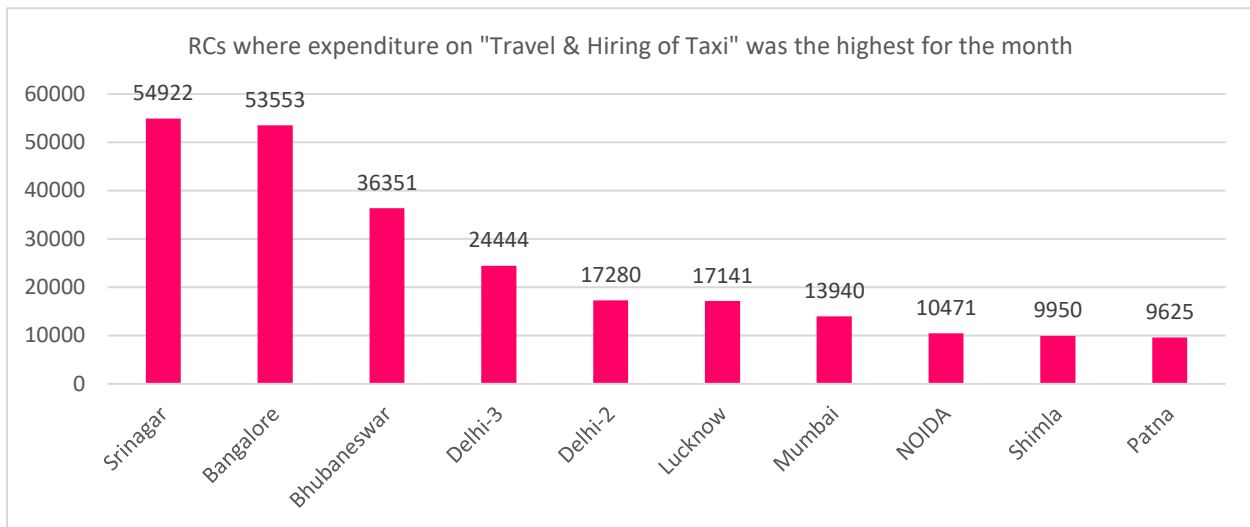

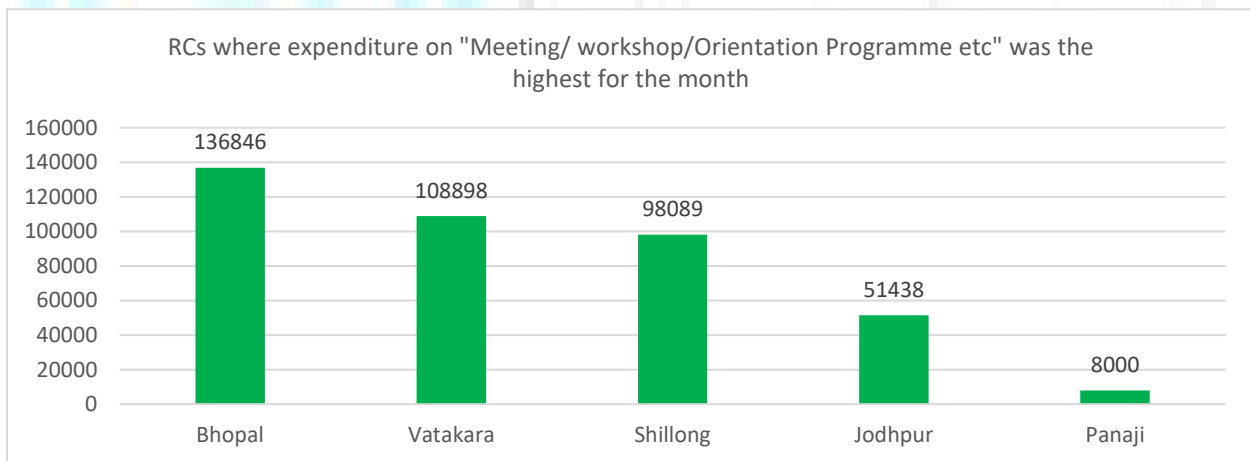

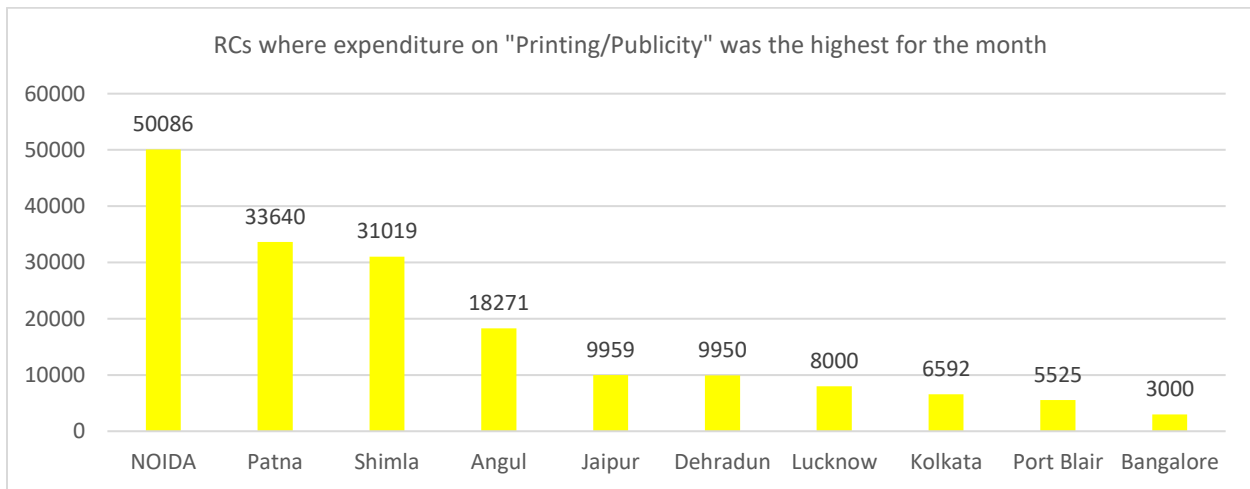

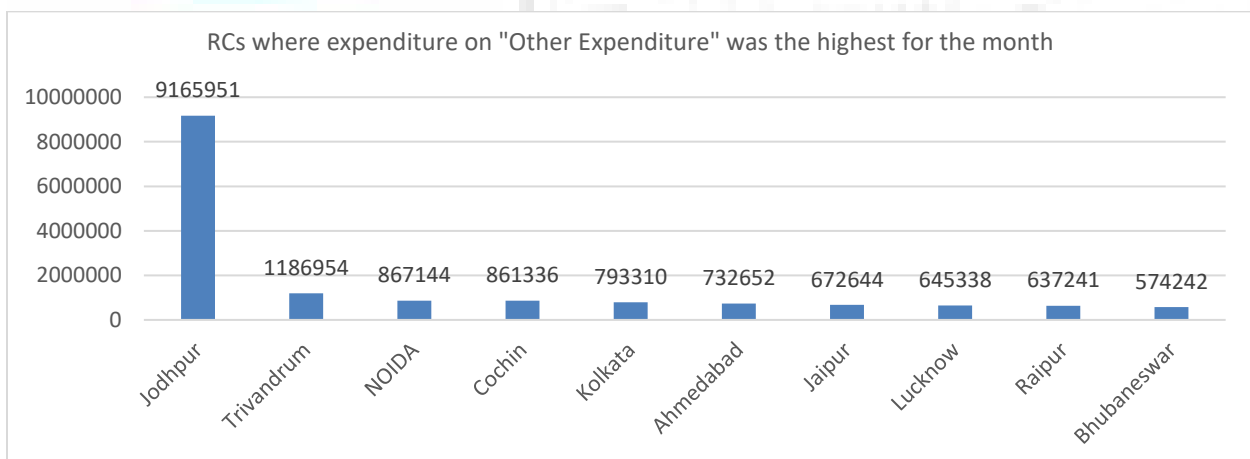

Expenditures for Functioning of Learner Support Centres

Expenses on the operations and functions of the Learners Support Centres are an important component of the university's expense. The expenses are made for salaries of part time functionaries (PTFs) of study centres as well as payments for academic counselling sessions, evaluation, and other administrative activities. Expenditures incurred for these activities are given in tables 51 to 53.

As far as salaries of part-time functionaries of study centres is concerned, a sum of Rs. 11092339/- was spent by all the regional centres during APRIL 2023 which accounted for 6.37% of total expenditure of Rs. 174010117/- incurred across the regional centres (table 51). Top-ten regional centres who incurred maximum expenses towards payment of salaries for the Part Time Functionaries in terms of percentage of total expenses have been given in figure 39. Thirty-four regional centres made nil payment on salaries of part-time functionaries of study centres during APRIL 2023.

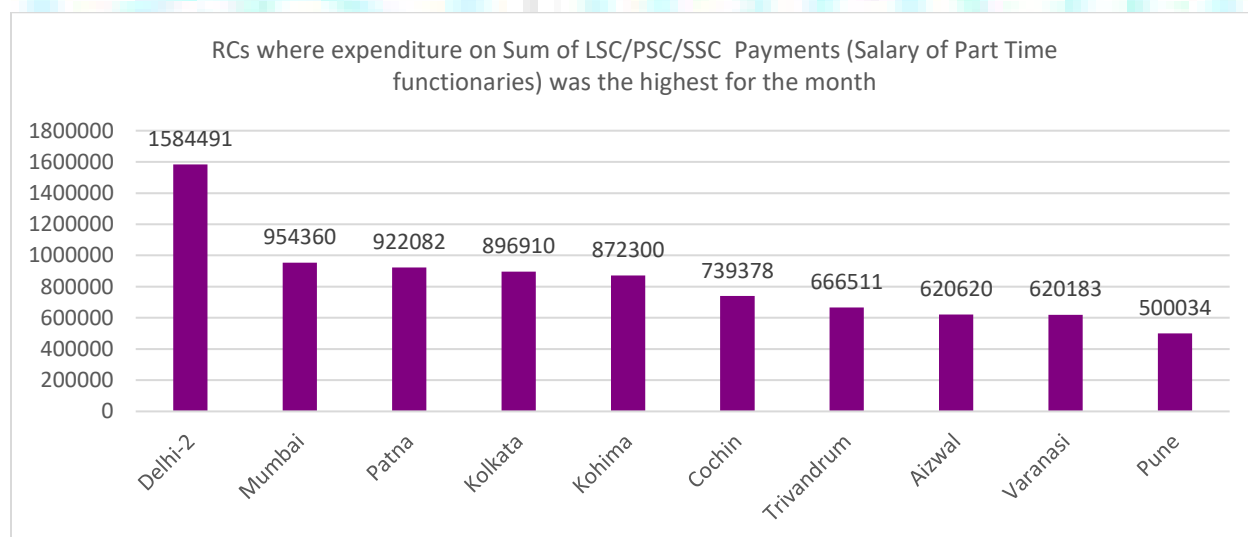

Regional Centre wise payments made for counselling and evaluation of assignments are given in table 52. The Regional Centres spent Rs. 117247100/- on payment of academic counsellors and for assignments evaluation, which accounted for 30.15% of the total expenditures of Rs. 236568175/. Figure 40 illustrates the top-ten regional centres who spent the highest amount for counselling and evaluation of assignments during APRIL 2023. 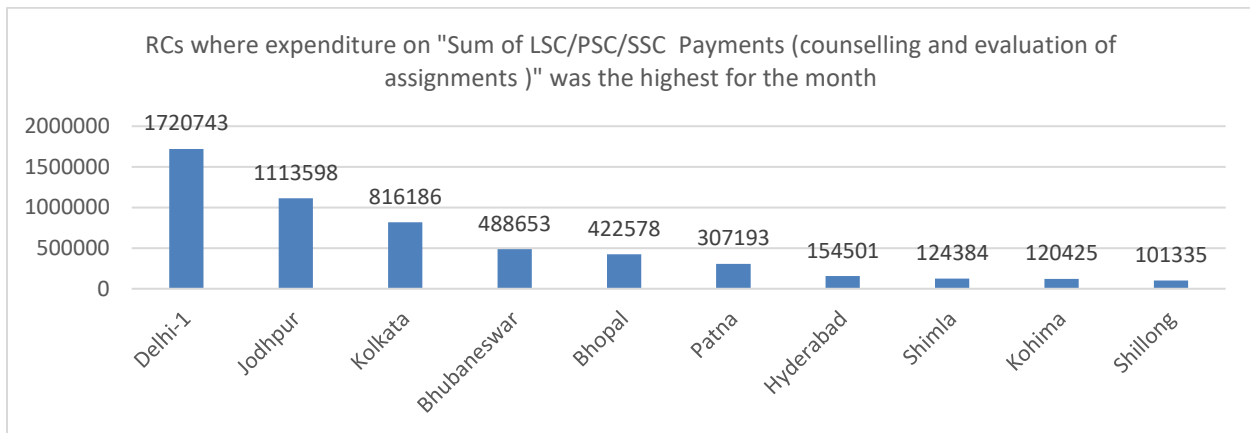

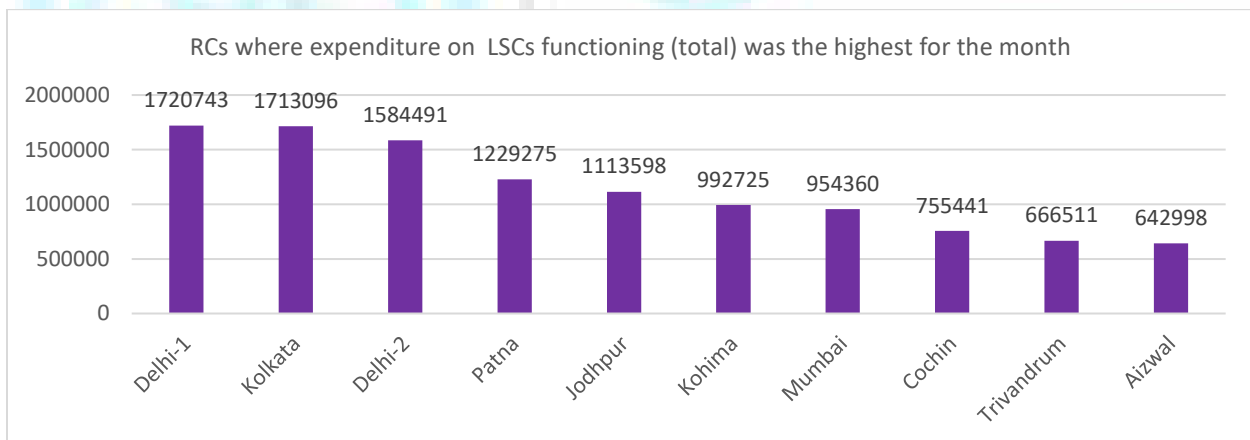

Staff strength at the Regional Centers

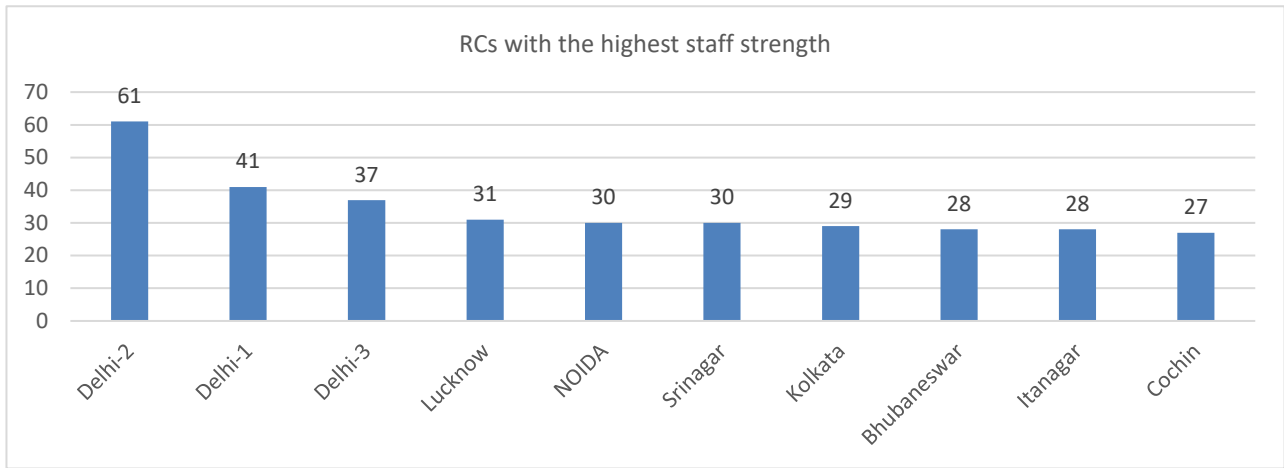

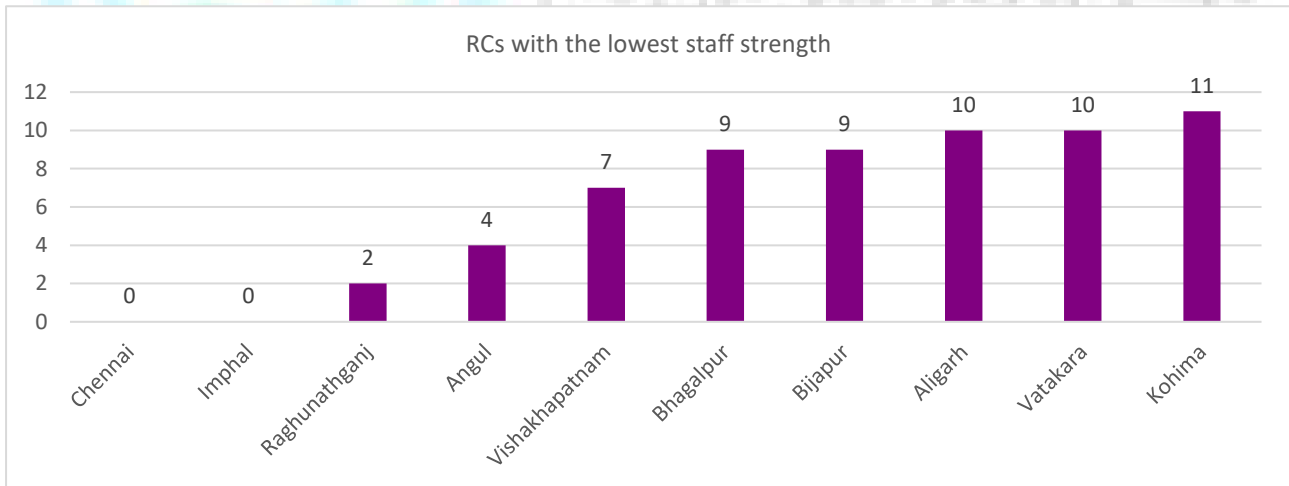

Ratio – Expenditure, Enrolment and Staff

The ratio is defined as the relation between two numbers which shows how much bigger one quantity is than another. In this study the ratio between expenditure and staff, expenditure and enrollment, enrolment and staff has been calculated in order to measure the magnitude of regional centers’ expenditure corresponding to staff posted as well as corresponding to the number of learners enrolled.

The higher the **Expenditure-to-Staff ratio**, the greater the expenditure per staff member at the Regional Centre, and *vice-versa*. The highest ratio was found in regional centre Jodhpur, while the lowest was found in regional centre Agartala (Table 55). Figure 44 shows the regional centers with the highest expenditure-to-staff ratio while figure 45 depicts the regional centers with the lowest expenditure-to-staff ratio.

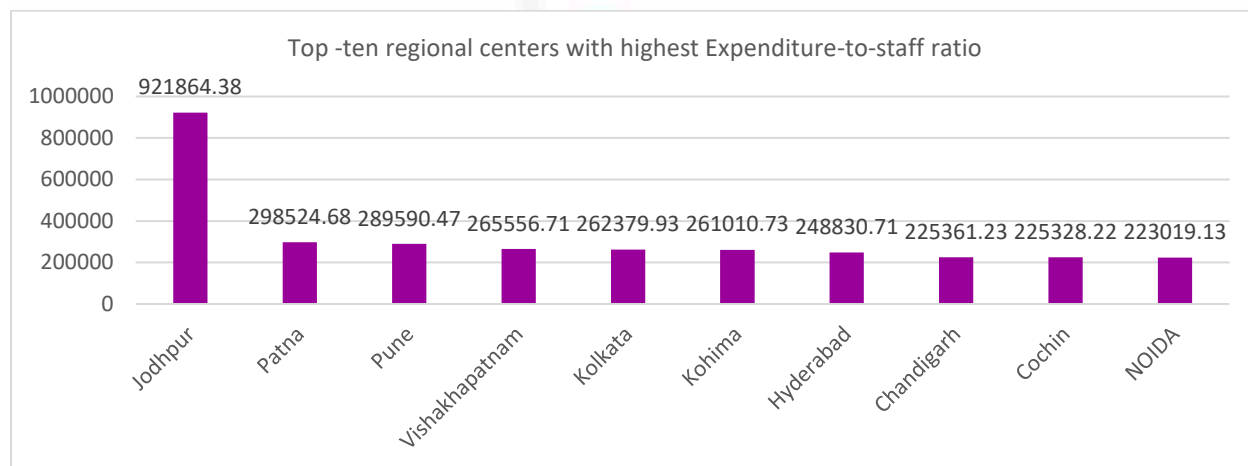

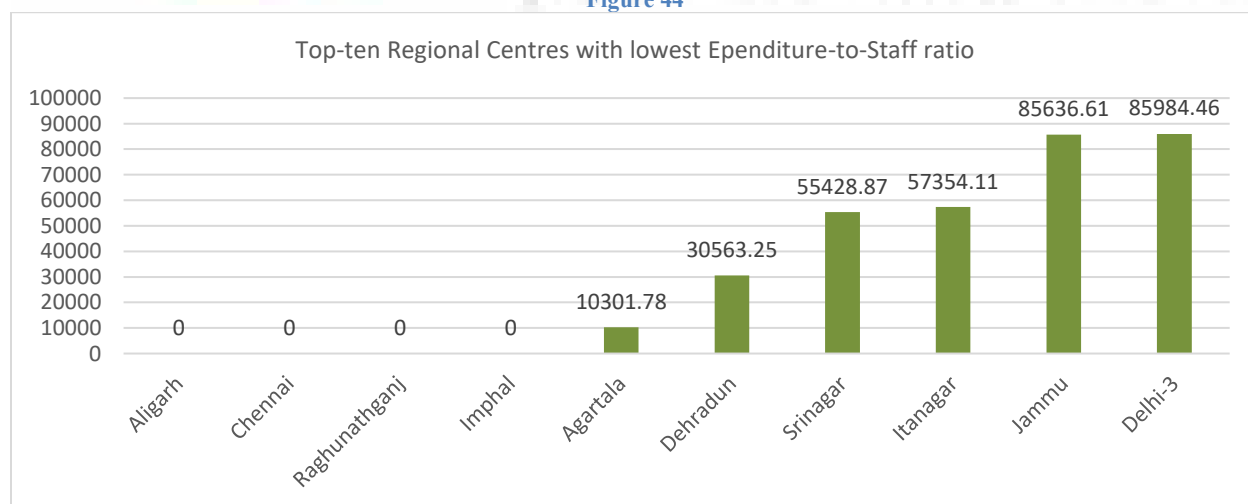

The higher the **Expenditure to enrolment ratio** as with other determined ratios, the more money that Regional center spends on each learner and vice-versa (Figure 46 and 47). Regional centre-wise expenditure to enrolment ratio has been given in the table 56.

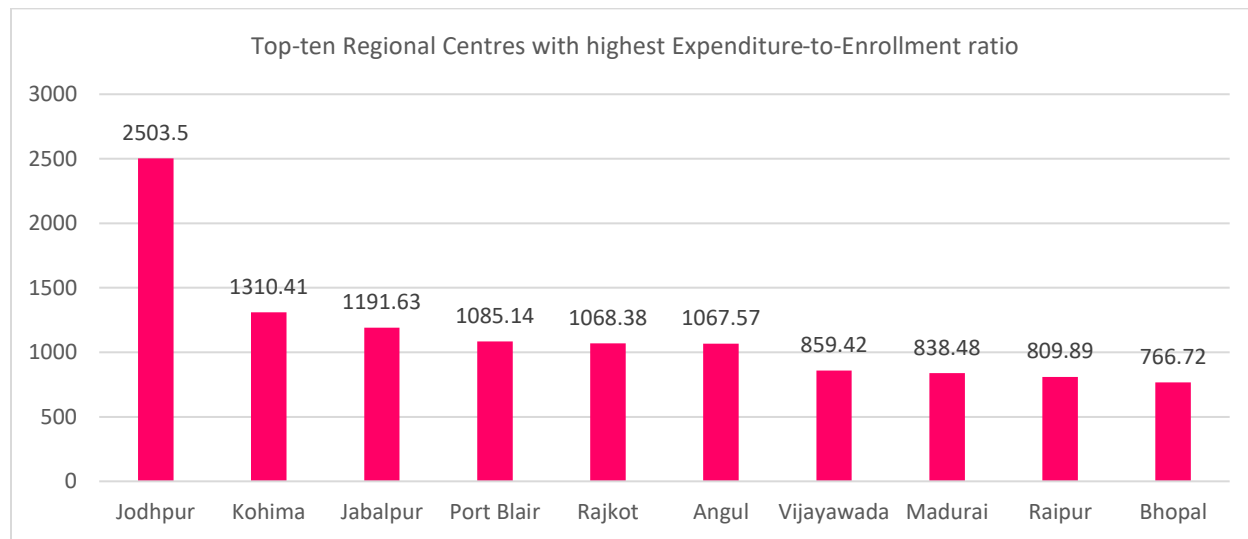

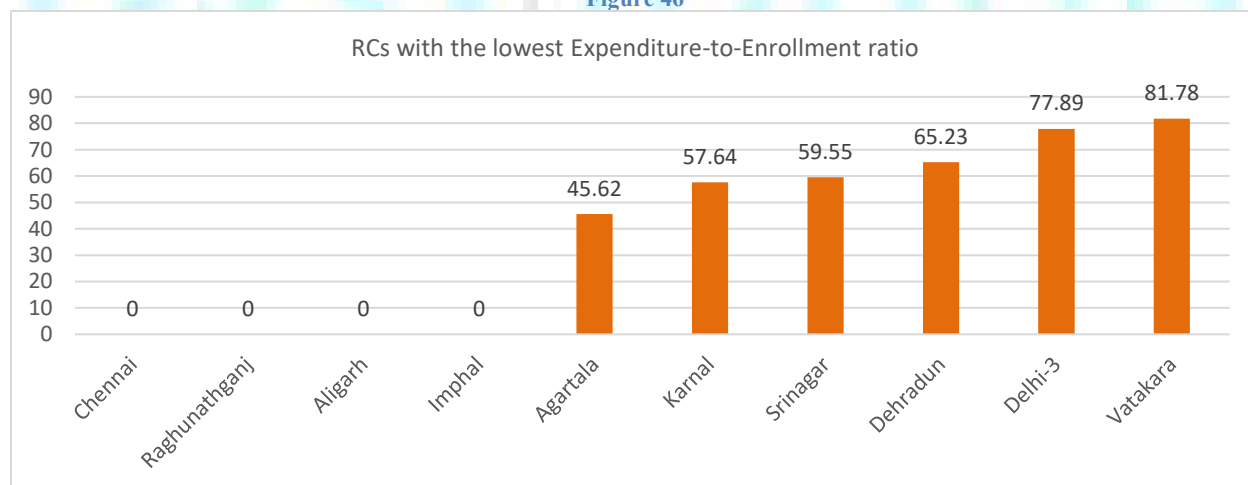

Similarly, Regional Centre wise **Enrolment to staff ratio** shows the workload in terms of the number of learners per staff member at each Regional Centre. The higher the expenditure-to-enrolment ratio, the more money that Regional Centre spends on each learner, and vice-versa (Figure 48 and 48). Regional centre Vatakara had the greatest ratio while regional centre Rajkot had the lowest (Table 57). 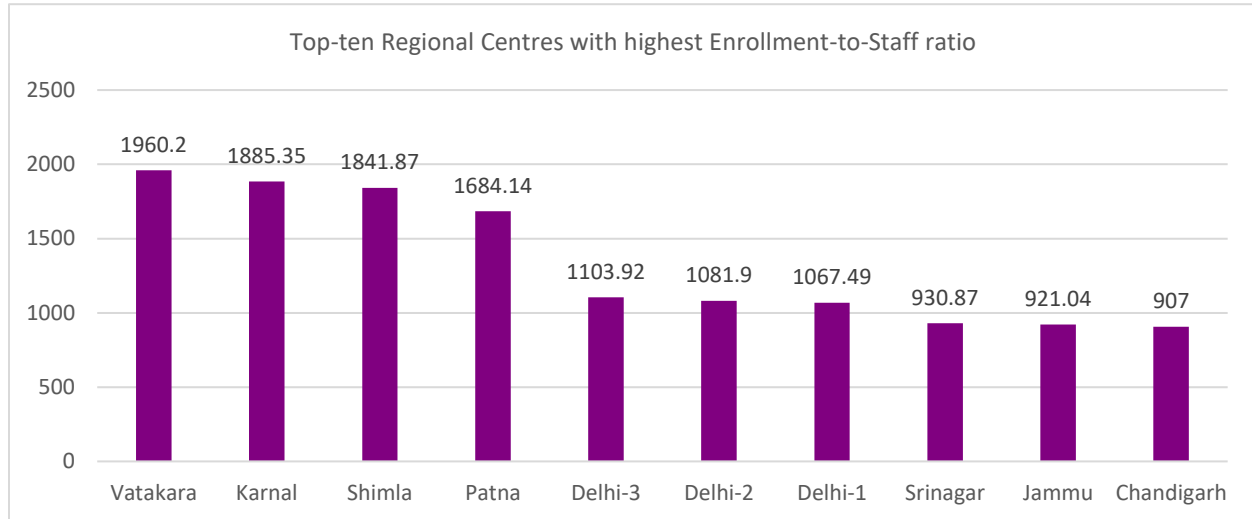

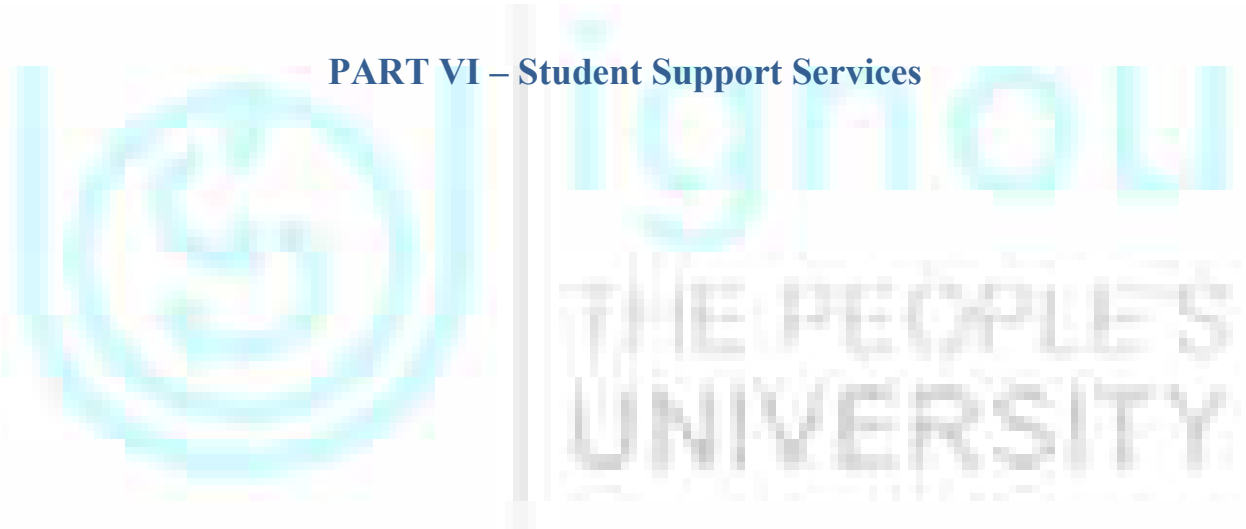

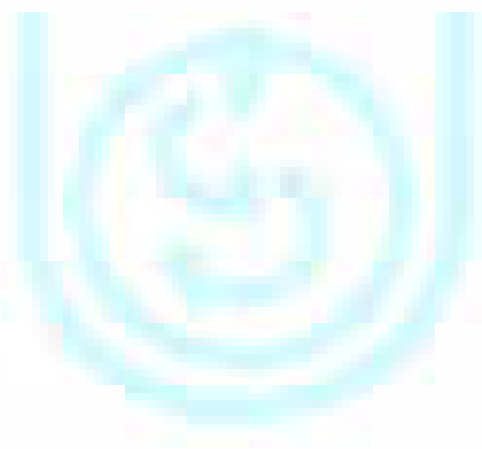

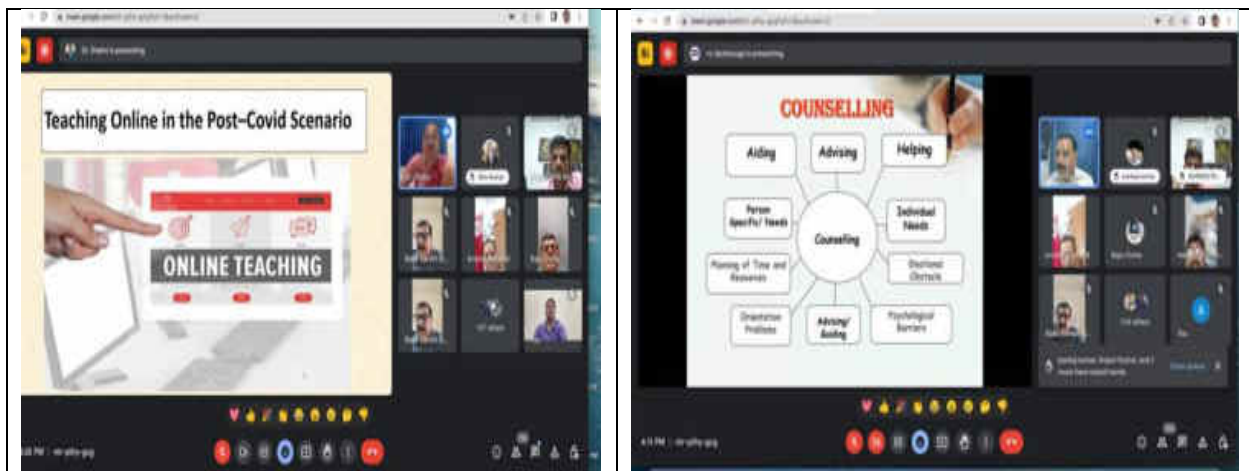
Online Coordinators' Meet 20.04.2023

Venue: Community Hall, Nongrimsadew, East Khasi Hills

Topic: “Natural Resource Management and Sustainable Agriculture”

Nongrimsadew is an adopted village of RC Shillong and situated 30 km. away from Shillong. There are approximately 65 Tribal families residing in this village. The village has 1 primary school up to class VII, a community hall, and a motorable road connected with NH 106. The population of the village is nearly 375. The major income sources are forest cultivation, daily wage labour, pig farming and small business. IGNOU Regional Centre Shillong in collaboration with Village Natural Resource Management Committee (VNRMC) organized an awareness programme on **Natural Resource Management and Sustainable Agriculture** at the Community Hall of Nongrimsadew, East Khasi Hills on 26/04/2023 from 11.00 a.m. onwards. Welcoming the participants, Dr. Rahul Bhattacharjee, Regional Director, informed the audience about the programmes offered by IGNOU and the fee exemption of certain programmes for students belonging to ST/ST. The Village Headman of the Nongrimsade, Mr. Alphone A Kharkongor expressed his happiness and gratitude to IGNOU for selecting the village for the awareness programme. Mr. Pynshngain Skhemlang Rymmai, District Project Manager CLLMP, East Khasi Hills explain the significance of the Community-led Landscape Management Project (CLLMP).

He informed that the project is a World Bank-supported project of the state of Meghalaya which aims to strengthen and manage community-led natural resources through a landscape approach, strengthening communities by building capacities and sustainable management of natural resources for economic growth. The resource person of the awareness programme, Mr Ananda Barua, a freelancer, spoke extensively about how to manage the natural resources for sustainable agriculture. Using bilingual language English and Khasi, he explained to the audience the meaning of natural resources in a practical sense, how human interference destroyed these resources, overuse of plastic, harmful chemicals, deforestation and other human activity destroy the environment. Using primary data collected from local researchers and secondary data available through national-international agencies he explained the various facts and concerns of the recent report on different environmental issues. IV. Monitoring of BSCG practical at IGNOU SC 1101

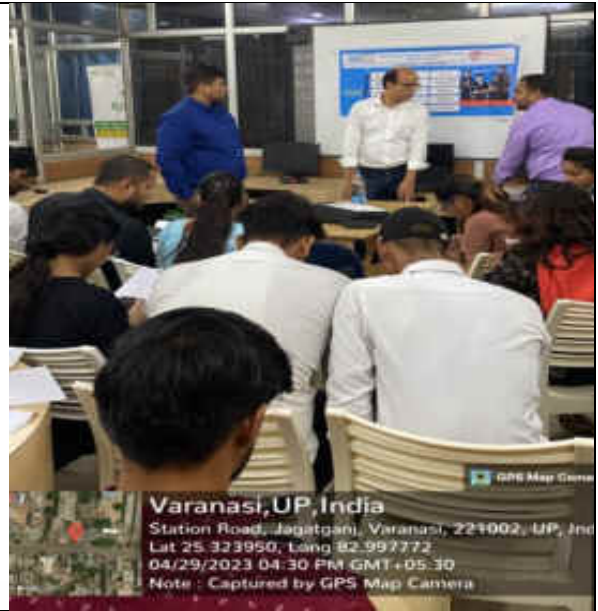
