Profile

Prof Manjulika Srivastava is amongst the few Indians to have done a doctorate in the field of Open and Distance Education. She has done her graduation, post-graduation and M.Phil in Liberal Arts from University of Delhi. She was till recently working as a Professor of Distance Education at the Distance Education Council (DEC), IGNOU, and subsequently Distance Education Bureau (DEB), University Grants Commission, which is the apex body for Open and Distance Learning (ODL) system in the country. She has been working with IGNOU since 1989 and has served as the Director of the Distance Education Council (2008 to 2010). Currently she is a Professor at IGNOUs Staff Training and Research institute of Distance Education (STRIDE).

She has done extensive research in the area of distance education and has published 8 books, around 70 articles and research papers mainly in the area of distance education both nationally and internationally. She has participated in national and international conferences and has visited all the major Open Universities in the world. She has coordinated the course design and delivery of programmes of the IGNOU. She has edited courses and written course material for IGNOU and other OUs. She has conducted several staff development programmes for distance educators in universities all over India and also for UNESCO, UNDP and COL. She is serving/has served on academic, research and management boards of several universities in the country, including

IGNOU. She was awarded the Faculty Research fellowship for the year 2002, by the Shastri Indo-Canadian Institute and was attached to Athabasca University, Canada's Open University.
