ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

The Indira Gandhi National Open University, one of the largest open universities in the world, was established by an Act of Parliament in 1985, to advance and disseminate learning and knowledge by a diversity of means, including the use of information and communication technology, to provide opportunities for higher education to a large segment of the population. Four disciplines/ areas namely, Education, Distance Education, Educational Technologies and Adult Education have been assigned to the School. - iii) To improve the overall performance of the school.
- iv) To develop a trained and competent cadre of head teachers/principals.

Extended Contact Programme (ECP)

ECP is a compulsory component of PGDSLM, based on theoretical components of PGDSLM. It aims at developing skills and competencies needed for effective school leadership and management. It consists of lectures, discussions, individual and group activities.

Eligibility

Prospective and In-service Head Teachers/Principal with Graduate Degree from a recognized University OR Graduate/Post Graduate Teachers

Fee

Rs.6000/- (Six thousand only) plus registration fee of Rs.300/- $\,$

Fee may be revised periodically.

Duration

Minimum : One Year Maximum : Three Years (Offered in both January & July cycle admissions)

Medium of Instruction

The programme is offered both in English and Hindi medium.

Evaluation

The evaluation system is based on three components:-

- a) Self-evaluation exercises within each unit of study (No weightage)
- b) Continuous evaluation in the form of assignments-this component carries weightage of 30% for each course.
- c) Term-end examination (TEE) has a weightage of 70% of the total weightage for each course.
- d) Extended contact programme (Compulsory).

Instructional System

The Instruction package consists of:-

- Print materials
- Audio/video programmes.

• Academic counselling session and ECP Attendance in academic counseling is optional whereas it is compulsory for ECP.
