Message from the Vice Chancellor

Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) was established by an Act of Parliament in 1985 to provide access to quality higher education to all segments of the society. The objective of the University is to offer high-quality, innovative and need-based programmes at different levels, to the aspirants and reach out to the disadvantaged segments across the country and overseas at an affordable cost. In more than — three and half decades of its existence, IGNOU has recorded a mammoth growth with an estimated cumulative enrolment of nearly 36 lakh students.



The academic programmes developed by the 21 Schools of Studies are delivered through a network of 69 Regional Centres and nearly 2100 Learner Support Centres (LSCs) across the country. The University has a considerable international presence in 16 countries through 23 Overseas Study Centres. In recognition of the quality academic programmes offered through the extensive network of regional and study centers across the country and overseas, the University has been awarded A++ Grade by NAAC.

IGNOU has witnessed a transition to the online digital mode of teaching-learning evident in its technology-enabled instructional design, digitalized content, facilities for tele-education and repository of digital learning resources. The technology-supported facilities like the online admission and reregistration system, examination form submission system, online grievance redress portal, online portal for empanelment of academic counsellors, etc. further strengthen the student support services. The University has launched 44 online programmes at degree, diploma, and certificate levels.

IGNOU has translated into practice many recommendations of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 of Govt. of India. Initiatives have been taken for skill development of learners, for which IGNOU has signed MOU with organizations such as the National Workers Board, National Skill Development Corporation, Ministry of Skill Development. As a major step IGNOU has signed MOU with the Indian Army, India Navy and Indian Air Force for offering specially designed Skill-based Bachelor Degree Programme to Agniveers.

In addition to providing student support services the Regional Centres also organize various activities for implementation of the policies of Government of India such as Swacchata Abhiyan, health and hygiene related programmes, Yoga based physical, mental health programmes. Activities have been undertaken by the Regional Centres under the Village Adoption Scheme of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan-2.0, a flagship programme of the GOI, celebration of Ek Bharat shreshtha Bharat Week and ongoing events under the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav.

INTRODUCTION

IGNOU was established by an Act of Parliament in 1985 to provide access to quality higher education to all segments of the society. IGNOU has a nation-wide learner support network for providing student support services, including face-to-face counselling and technology enabled academic as well as administrative support. IGNOU has been steadily expanding opportunities for life-long higher education and democratizing education by making it inclusive. The University offers its academic programmes through 21 Schools of Studies and a network of 69 Regional Centres (RC), more than 2000 Learner Support Centres (LSCs). The Regional Services Division (RSD), is the nodal division for providing learner support within the country.

1. REGIONAL SERVICES DIVISION

The RSD began its operations in 1986 and was entrusted with the responsibility of developing policies, systems, and procedures, establishing, and managing student support systems through a network RCs and LSCs. RSD is entrusted with the responsibility of ensuring quality learner support services. The Student Services Committee (SSC), a Standing Committee of the Board of Management, is housed in the RSD. SSC formulates the policies and guidelines for effective learner support. During the reporting period 51st SSC was held on January 27, 2022.

RSD has expanded its network by establishing 57 RCs which includes 9 RCs in the Northeast region and 48 RCs in the rest of the country. Apart from these RCs, 12 Recognized Regional Centres (RRCs) have been established, which includes seven with Army, four with Navy and one with Assam Rifles, thus taking the total number of RCs to 69. IGNOU has established 1 sub-RC in Leh for Ladakh region.

The vast network of RCs operating through a network of 2036 LSCs extends the outreach of IGNOU to the deprived rural, remote, socially, and physically disadvantaged segments of population, providing them access to quality and cost-effective higher education in a flexible manner. The establishment of a Regional Centre in Angul district of Odisha, was approved by the Board of Management at its 149th meeting held on 26.05.2022 and the Regional Centre Angul was notified on 24th June 2022.

1.1 Infrastructure Development: Physical and Digital

RCs with Permanent Buildings: Under Construction & Operational

The RCs are operating from their own buildings and from rented premises as well. The University lays thrust on rational use of physical infrastructure in tune with the requirements of technological interventions for effective delivery mechanisms in ODL and online education. As on date 11 RCs are operating from their own buildings and construction work is under progress at 10 RCs. The building of RC Karnal was inaugurated in virtual mode, on 24-01-2022, by the Hon'ble Minister of Education in the presence of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Haryana.



Regional Evaluation Centers (REC) in RCs with Own Buildings

RECs have been shifted to the RCs having their own buildings. The six RCs with their own buildings have provided space to the RECs, namely at Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Cochin, Lucknow, Shillong, and Patna.

LSC Located in Regional Centre Premises

Learner support services are also being provided to learners by all the RCs from their own premises. The LSC located in the RC is assigned a code and mostly equipped with the requisite infrastructure, such as ICT enabled rooms/labs for conduct of academic counseling. The academic support for conduct of theory and practical counseling sessions, evaluation of assignments and other support services are organized with the help of academic counselors from local LSCs in the region. From the academic session July 2022 all the Regional Centres have been activated for all the Online programmes of the University. It is a major departure

from earlier practice of running the Online Programmes which were operationalized by the Centre of Online Education (COE). The RC LSCs are taking up this additional assignment with effective coordination with COE. All the RC LSCs have carried out the training of academic counselors, students, and the delivery of counseling/ assignment evaluation/online examinations for the Online Programs in addition to ODL programs.

Regional Centers also serve as a resource center of the University in the region. All the Regional Centers are provided with a well-equipped library which includes reference books and Self Learning Materials (SLMs) of the academic programs offered by IGNOU in multiple media formats (print, audio/ video etc).

1.2 Digital/ICT-enabled Infrastructure at Regional Centers

As IGNOU uses ICT extensively for both the academic and administrative support services, the RCs have been equipped with computer systems, E-Mail, Fax, Satellite Receivers, Reprographic facilities, TV, Internet connection and all RC campuses are Wi-Fi enabled. The Regional Centers have been equipped with DTH facilities to enable access to Gyan Darshan T.V. Channel and to facilitate the learners to watch the educational programs through the Gyan Darshan channel. Most of the LSCs have also been provided the DTH facility to access the IGNOU programs. All Learner Support Centres have been provided with broadband facilities.

1.3 Creation of New Regional Centre at Angul

There is a need to optimize the resources of the University to strengthen the student support services. In some of the place's activities need to be scaled down where as in other places there is a need to scale up the activities. It will help to provide better support services to learners in rural and remote areas and particularly to aspirational districts to fulfil the mandate of the National Education Policy- 2020. Keeping this mandate in mind Regional Services Division proposed to establish a new Regional Centre in Angul district in Odisha with jurisdiction over districts of Sambalpur, Sundargarh, Bargarh, Deogarh, Sonepur and Boudh. Angul is a major industrial hub in the state having NALCO, NTPC, Mahanadi Coal Fields Ltd, Talcher Thermal Power, Jindal steel, Bhushan steel etc which are potential source of employment and apprenticeship/internship. Currently fifteen Study Centres are operating under the proposed Regional Centre. It was felt that many new LSCs can be opened to meet the educational aspirations of youth of the region, industrial workers, and their family members. It was also decided that the centre will operate from rent-free/rented accommodation. RC Angul was notified via Notification no: IGI/Admn(G)/Not/1832 dated: 24th June 2022.

2. TRANSITION FROM ODL TO ONLINE MODE

As the University has been gradually moving towards online delivery during 2022, the Regional Services Division has started revamping of its existing systems and operations. New domains of student support are being explored in alignment with NEP 2020. As mandated by NEP 2020, the University has prepared a ten-year roadmap, the IDP 2030 and its Vision document for its implementation, in nine major operational areas. The UGC Regulations 2020, stipulate the adoption of blended mode using ICTs for enhancing effectiveness of teaching - learning process and administrative functioning and encourage the use of OER and MOOCs by HEIs. The IGNOU Guidelines on Standards of Excellence 2019, emphasize the use of multiple media and ICT enabled mechanisms for effective delivery of academic programmes, administrative operations, and student support. During the period 2022, RSD has undertaken major initiatives for strengthening student support services, in view of the transition from ODL to online mode of instruction. Some of these initiatives e.g., Swayam Prabha mediated academic support in regional languages, Nodal RCs initiative, Enhanced use of social media (Facebook, twitter, Instagram etc) has significantly added value to support services operations of the University. These initiatives are in alignment with the mandate of National Education Policy 2020, UGC's ODL and Online Regulations 2020 and the IGNOU Institutional Development Plan 2030.

In view of the transition of IGNOU to digital and online mode for its academic and administrative operations and in the above stated contexts there is need to redefine the role and functions of Regional Centres. The activities envisaged and initiated in this direction as follows:

- a) The meetings for administrative and academic purposes have been largely organized through google/zoom meeting apps. The Regional Centers have organized many webinars and sensitization programmes for prospective learners. The details are given in Annexure.
- b) The practice of accepting scanned copies of assignments continued during the year 2022 and a large number of scanned copies of assignments were processed by the Regional Centres. It has greatly facilitated all those students who live far away from their Learner Support Centres.
- c) As per the decision of the University, during 2022, 100% online counselling was conducted by the Regional Centres. Nodal Centres were identified for several programmes to give centralized counselling. Joint counselling sessions were conducted for ODL and Online programmes, wherever the students' strength in online programmes was less. For some of the programmes online support has also been given for practical programmes also.
- d) Technology has empowered Regional Centres to extend their jurisdiction for providing support services to overseas learners. IGNOU Regional Centre Delhi-1 has successfully provided support services to about 900 learners enrolled in 25 programmes in Guyana in South America

- in January 2022 cycle of admissions. This pilot initiative has opened opportunities for other Regional Centres to serve learners residing overseas
- e) The organization of student support for online programmes is under the overall supervision of RSD. The activities of all the RCs were monitored by RSD and monthly monitoring reports were submitted to PVC/VC for information. The academic support services such as Academic Counselling, Assignment Submission, Online Grievance Redressal Camps, Project Viva-Voce, Practical Classes etc. were provided by all the RCs. However nodal RCs were also identified for selected programmes to centrally provide academic support to students.
- f) The academic counselling is being organised through 20 different Regional Centres in regional languages. It has been a major paradigm shift in the functioning of the Regional Centres. It has made the counselling more learner friendly for students and significantly enhanced the reach of counselling services over a large geographical area of the country at a much-reduced cost. The list of these centres is given in Annexure.

Some key initiatives undertaken are as follows:

2.1 Learner Support Services in Online Programmes by Regional Centers

During 2022, the Regional Centres facilitated the academic activities for IGNOU learners for online programmes during both the academic cycles. This new responsibility assigned to Regional Centres called for training of ACs in LMS, Training of officials of RCs, evaluation of assignments on LMS, Transmission of grades to SED, identification of suitable institutions for online examinations and conduct of online examinations. The RCs have effectively carried out the responsibilities with the effective coordination with Centre of Online Education (COE) and Students Evaluation Division (SED). IGNOU has launched 41 Online programmes as on date. In the initial phase the learner support services were coordinated by 7 Regional Centers i.e., 4 in Delhi-NCR, i.e., RC Delhi-1, Delhi-2, Delhi-3, NOIDA, and 3 RCs for MBA OL programme, i.e., RC Lucknow, Bhopal and Jaipur, in addition to RC NOIDA. However, for the academic session July 2022, all the online programmes were activated in all the Regional Centres. Academic Counseling in all the online programmes is being done through the LMS platform and practical counseling as per guidelines of the respective School of Study. The academic support from all these RCs was streamlined by RSD through frequent google meetings, training programmes and development of Standard Operating Procedures. The Orientation Programmes (O.P.) in Online mode for the Academic Counsellors and Evaluators of 7 RCs was held on 2nd April 2022 which was inaugurated by the Vice Chancellor Prof. Nageshwar Rao. From the July 2022 session onwards, all RCs are being involved in the online delivery of student support services. Guidelines have been issued by RSD to the RCs for providing student support services in the online programmes. A summary of the online Learner Support activities undertaken by RCs



2.2 Redressal of Students Grievances

Receiving and resolving student grievances is an important activity at the Regional Centres and study centres. Handling of student queries and grievances are crucial for effective student support services. All Regional Centres answer students' issues face-to-face as well as via Email, Telephone, Post, Facebook, and other means. In 2022, special initiatives have been taken by Regional Centres to assign the responsibility of students' grievances redressal to a nodal person who is drawn from the regular staff of the Regional Centre. The list of such nodal persons and their mobile numbers has been shared with Students Services Division (SSC) for better coordination of the grievance redressal. Since the pandemic, Regional Centres and Study Centres also organized online grievance redressal camps to address students queries and problems related to their studies.

2.3 Monitoring Student grievances on i-GRAM

RSD has been monitoring the student grievances redressal done by the RCs through the i-GRAM portal on a weekly basis. The RCs are required to submit to RSD the status of the queries received, resolved, forwarded, and pending on the i-GRAM portal for the whole week, through a google link. The data is downloaded and compiled every Friday and placed before the competent authority and the status is shared with the RCs. The daily status of student grievances (RC wise) on the I-GRAM portal is also monitored by RSD and the status is reported to the RCs with the weekly report. The analysis of weekly and daily status reveals the following:

- Almost all the Regional Centres are able to bring down pendency to zero within a span of a week's time. The weekly feedback is taken from the Regional Centres and submitted to higher authorities. The status is shared with all the RCs on weekly basis and defaulters (if any) are identified. This has been a major achievement of the Regional Centres to maintain nearly zero pendency of students' grievances.
- The number of grievances forwarded to other Divisions/Schools is around 20% of the grievances received. The number of grievances on the last working day is high and the RCs need to resolve the queries daily. It has been an area of concern for RSD.
- In order to minimize the response time for students' grievances, regional centres have been motivated to bring down pendency to zero level on day-to-day basis. The RSD has made efforts to monitor the RC wise pendency of grievances on day-to-day basis. RC wise daily data of pending grievances is compiled, monitored, and circulated among the Regional Centres. The efforts of RSD have improved the response time of Regional Centre.

The RC wise grievance redressal pattern has been monitored for entire year 2022 and the status is given in Annexure.

3. COLLABORATIVE INITIATIVES FOR SKILL DEVELOPMENT

IGNOU has taken several initiatives and is collaborating with various institutions to foster skill development and its integration with knowledge based higher education through distance/ digital mode. This is in consonance with the National Education policy (NEP) 2020 which has emphasized on integrating Skill/Vocational education into Higher Education and has envisaged offering of holistic, multidisciplinary skill-based education by Higher Educational Institutions, with the objective to give boost to skilled workforce in the country and also to increase Gross Enrolment Ratio to 50% by the year 2035.

The activities being undertaken by IGNOU for Skill Training are as follows:

3.1 Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship for Linking Vocational education with Higher Education

MoU was signed between MSDE and IGNOU on 18th January 2022 for linking vocational education with higher education and declaring NSTIs, ITIs, PMKK & JSS as IGNOU Centers. Thirty three NSTIs have already been declared as IGNOU-MSDE Extension centers and these centers are now enlisted in the SAMARTH Online Admission Portal since January 2022 session.

3.2 Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi

MoU was signed between IGNOU and Central Sanskrit University (CSU) on 27th July 2022. One of the major activities envisaged under the MoU is opening IGNOU study centres in different campuses of CSU. The CSU has the main campus in Delhi and twelve regional campuses across the country in different states. The MoU also seeks to promote Sanskrit education in the context of NEP 2020 by conducting workshops and training courses for Teachers Training jointly by CSU and IGNOU.

3.3 DT National Board for Workers Education and Development, New Delhi

MoU was signed between IGNOU and DTNBWED on 19th September 2022 wherein IGNOU and DTNBWED have jointly agreed to collaborate for education, training, and capacity building of a large workforce in the country. Four programs have been conceptualized through collaboration, of which two at the Certificate level on Trade Unionism & Labor Laws and on Labor Codes, are for the organized sector and two at Appreciation level on Digital Literacy and Capacity building are for the unorganized sector. IGNOU shall design curricula, identify course contents, credit points, study hours and evaluation system and develop the audio-video resources and implement the programs as per IGNOU norms. DTNBWED shall collaborate with IGNOU to facilitate and motivate the workers for registration, and promote the proposed programs. DTNBWED will develop the course content for Certificate programmes and repurpose and adapt the content for Appreciation programmes.

3.4 National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), New Delhi

MoU was signed between IGNOU and NSDC on 29th September 2022 to collaborate on multiple initiatives for providing opportunities for enhancing and sharpening the 21st century skills of students through quality and inclusive education thereby contributing towards making India the Skill Capital of the World. The MoU seeks to fulfill the main aim of NEP 2020 which is to develop vocational capacities alongside the development of 'academic' or other capacities.

The initiative of embedding skilling across courses would foster industry connect and enhance employability of the workforce in the country.

3.5 MoU with Defense Forces for Offering Skill based Bachelor's Degree Program for *Agniveers*

In alignment with the vision of NEP-2020, the University will design and offer a Bachelor Degree Programme, blending theoretical knowledge in core disciplines with practical skills acquired in-service by the Defence Services personnel. The Indian Army, the Indian Navy and the Indian Air Force have signed MoUs with IGNOU for offering Skill-based Bachelor Degree Programme to Agniveers on 22-12-2022. The scheme of offering Skill-based Bachelor Degree Programme to Agniveers provides for recognition and acceptance of credits earned from NSQF-aligned skill training courses (at the level 4.5 and above) offered inservice by the Defence Establishments.

3.6 Collaboration with the National Council for Vocational Education & Training IGNOU will be collaborating with the National Council for Vocational Education & Training (NCVET), a skill regulator of the country, for dual recognition as an Awarding body and Assessing body for the skill-based programmes. A Letter of Intent (LOI) for considering

grant of recognition as Awarding Body (AB – Dual) was issued by the Council on the 20th September 2022. As per the LOI, the University is required to sign an agreement with NCVET.

3.7 Sensitization Drives by Regional centers for Expansion of IGNOU- MSDE Extension Centers

Varanasi

Hon'ble Minister of Education and Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Government in India, Dr. Dharmendra Pradhan and Vice Chancellor IGNOU, Prof. Nageshwar Rao, visited IGNOU-MSDE Extension Centre (Code: 48ITI001) at Govt. ITI (Near BHU), Varanasi. Hon'ble Minister Dr. Dharmendra Pradhan enquired about the programmes being offered by IGNOU to ITI students. He took a keen interest in Graduate Degree level programmes of IGNOU like BA(Voc)MSME, BSCG, BCOMG and BAG etc. which are being offered to ITI students.

In one-hour, long meeting with IGNOU and other stakeholders Dr. Pradhan highlighted the role of IGNOU as Academic partner of Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship in academic growth and skill development of ITI students. Bhopal

The Virtual Inauguration Ceremony of NSTI Centers was attended by 23 officials of NSTI Indore under IGNOU Regional Centre Bhopal. The Principal Mr. V. Babu also interacted with the dignitaries during the inauguration ceremony. The other officials who attended the Virtual function included Training Officers, Vocational Instructors, and other staff of the NSTI Indore. Senior faculty members from Holkar Science College, IGNOU Study Centre Indore and from Govt. PG College, Mhow Indore were also present during the inauguration function.



A meeting was held with Regional Director of Regional Directorate of Skill Entrepreneurship (RDSE) Bhopal wherein several strategies were discussed for disseminating the information amongst the stakeholders.

Conducted 2 Face to Face Meetings for training officials on IGNOU modalities apart from 4 virtual meets to sensitize the students and officials from ITI/PMKK/JSS/NSTI. Mails with details were sent to the concerned institutions to sensitize their learners about IGNOU programmes. NSTI registration centre has been opened at Calicut. We have also processed the applications for registration centres received from it is in Calicut district.



Trivandrum

Consequent upon the MoU signed by IGNOU and Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) to link vocational education and training with higher education, IGNOU MSDE Extension Centre has been established at NSTI (W), Trivandrum. Orientation programmes for students, faculty and staff members were organized and eleven students have enrolled for various IGNOU programmes. The initiative aims at providing an opportunity for the learners of NSTI centres and ITIs to join the programmes being offered by IGNOU. Nearly 200 participants including Principals, Faculties and learners of NSTI Kazhakootam and ITI Kazhakootam.



Raipur

The Regional Centre has proactively expedited the matter pertaining to promote skill and need based programmes in the state of Chhattisgarh. Conducted online meeting with the JSS, state employment and training and the Directorate of state skill development and entrepreneurship. Constant touch with the state Govt. for promoting IGNOU's academic programmes in the Region.

4. RSD ACTIVITIES DURING 2022 - AN OVERVIEW

4.1 Coordinating Student Support Services for International Learners *GOAL-Guyana Project*


The Guyana Online Academy of Learning (GOAL), Guyana in the July 2021 session sponsored 804 learners in 25 programmes for the July 2021 session. The programmes include 09 Certificate level programmes, 06 Diploma programmes, 07 PG Diploma programmes, 02 Bachelor Degree programmes and 01 Awareness programmes. Regional Centre Delhi-1 was identified as the Nodal Centre for providing the academic support services to these learners. RC, with the help of 62 Academic Counsellors including IGNOU Faculty, prepared the Counselling Schedules for these GOAL Learners of July 2021 session as per Guyana Timings (GYT). In the January 2022 Session, 171 students enrolled in the MAPC programme and all theory sessions have been completed. BCA-2nd Semester 24 students re-registered all the theory/practical counselling sessions have been completed. In the July 2022 Session, RC Delhi-1 got 236 students in 14 programmes. The Induction programmes have been conducted in the last week of September 2022 for all 14 programmes.



E-Vidyabahrti Project

The e-VidyaBharti and e-ArogyaBharti (e-VBAB) Network Project, under the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA), GOI, offers Tele-education & Tele-medicine services through internet-based web portals. So far, 6 premiers Indian HEIs, approved by University Grants Commission (UGC), are offering online degree/ diploma/ certificate programmes. Also, the MoUs have been signed with 19 African Countries to participate in e-VBAB project. Under this initiative, IGNOU is one of the HEIs identified for the e-VBAB project. 2618 learners have registered in 43 programmes at various levels ranging from the Certificate to PG degree level in the July 2022 admission session. The Regional Services Division (RSD) will provide the support services to these learners. The learners have been allotted the following 12 RCs:

Bangalore, Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Dehradun, Delhi-1, Delhi-3, Kolkata, Lucknow, Noida, Pune, Srinagar and Vatakara.



4.2 Promoting Multilingualism

Channel Based Counselling (CBC) in regional languages

The University is providing Channel-Based Counselling (CBC) through different regional languages in CBCS based programmes and MBA programme of IGNOU on SWAYAM PRABHA with effect from 1st January 2022. The channel-based counselling was initially operationalised at 20 RCs using four channels of SWAYAM PRABHA for the CBCS courses in 13 languages namely, *Assamese, Bengali, English, Gujarati, Hindi, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odia, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu* and *Urdu*. However, it was subsequently operationalised for MBA programme also in Delhi-1, Bhubaneswar, and Patna. The number of CBC sessions held at the 15 RCs up to 15th January 2023, is provided below:

Five other Regional Centers have already acquired the necessary infrastructure and approval of competent authority. These CBC center will be operationalized soon. Regional Services Division has been monitoring the activities of Channel Based Counselling e.g. scheduling of sessions, publicity measures, quality of videos, cancellation of sessions under emergency and training requirements. The day-to-day monitoring of the delivery through this mode is being carried out by officials of RSD. A detailed status report on Channel Based Counselling was prepared by Regional Services Division in 2022 and was submitted to higher authorities. Specific recommendations were made to further strengthen the delivery of Channel Based Counselling.


The Regional Centres are making all possible efforts to promote and create awareness about this activity through various measures like RC website, Press releases, social media (Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, Instagram etc), announcements in Web-conferences, mass SMS(s)/E Mails to students and through Learner Support Centres. Some of the Regional Centres have also taken initiatives to hold training programs for Resource Persons to ensure quality of the videos. The video content generated through CBC sessions become part of the COE's repository and can be accessed by prospective users. Regional Centres have taken initiatives to publicise the repository of videos on COE's web site.

Special Initiatives to Enhance Participation of disadvantaged segments e.g., Jail inmates, Physically Challenged Persons, people living in Naxal Affected Area etc

- a) Based on an extensive analysis of enrolment in jail study centers it was proposed in 51st meeting of Students Services Committee (SSC) held on 27th January 2022 that an exclusively different criterion of minimum number of enrollments be devised for continuation of LSC and appointment of Part-Time Coordinator in jail study centers. The 51st SSC approved and recommended that special study centers for jail inmates will be allowed to be operational even with the minimum enrollment of 10. This exclusive criterion has been developed to operationalize the centers for jail inmates with low enrolment.
 - It was also decided that, in case the above criterion is not fulfilled, the support services of learners at such LSC may be provided by the nearest Regular LSC and no further payments may be made to the LSC and the Part-Time Coordinator. Jail LSC with less than 10 enrolments to be kept in abeyance. However, if enrolment is less than 10 then support services may be provided by the nearest Regular LSC. The recommendations were notified vide Notification no: IG/RSD/Notification/51SSC/LSC in AICTE/2022/11139, dated: 15th Feb 2022.
- b) An extensive review of the students belonging to PH categories was also done during 2022 and status was prepared for placing it in the 52nd SSC.
- c) The people living in Naxal affected areas suffer from obvious constraints to take education. Moreover, there is lack of awareness about educational opportunities. During 2022, IGNOU's Regional Centre in Nagpur has made extensive efforts to sensitize the communities living in such areas. "GYAN GANGA Awareness Meets" are held in the interior tribal villages to explain them that they can continue their studies without much disturbance to their daily routine. Officials of Regional Centre meet the important influence makers of the Region and explain them the benefits of IGNOU Education. Similarly, the CRPF personnel working in the areas have also been a major target group for IGNOU's programmes. These personnels find it difficult to take education due to their job commitments in such areas. Therefore, awareness meetings were conducted with them within their organization to get them enrolled in IGNOU's programmes.
- d) Under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) four Naxal affected villages of Gadchiroli District were adopted and household survey was carried out in those villages. Despite the operational constraints in these areas Regional Centre is making efforts to reach out and bring them into mainstream education. Efforts have been made to enhance reach of support services for already enrolled learners. During the year 2022, Regional Centre, Nagpur explored the possibilities to establish a Regular Study Centre in Gondwana University at Gadchiroli to give better Academic Experience to students of these areas.

- e) The newly launched scheme of MSDE Extension Centers have proved handy to sensitize the ITI students in Naxal affect areas. IGNOU has established an Information Centre at the Jan Shikshan Sansthan at Gondia. As part of IGNOU-MSME MOU, IGNOU also established Information Centre at Government ITI, Gadchiroli and addressed Awareness Meeting for the ITI students and Faculty the purpose of the Centre and how they can upgrade their qualification through IGNOU and how beneficial it will be for their career. The vocational Health Education Programmes have become popular in the region and 100% employment was offered to some batch(s) students.
- f) In order to provide educational services of IGNOU to the border areas of Kashmir and Ladakh region, IGNOU Regional Centre Srinagar organized several activities for their benefit. Pre admission counselling sessions and induction programmes in both online and offline mode were organized besides other activities. One programme was conducted in NORTH KASHMIR, Uri Baramulla which is around 110 kms from Srinagar and few kms from salamabad post connecting Kashmir with POK. The people living here face several difficulties in getting access to education. A pre admission camp was conducted on November 12, 2022 in GDC Uri in which a large no of civil society members, defense personal, woman, panchayat representatives and young people of the area participated. Another programme was conducted by RC Srinagar in the remote and difficult area of SOUTH KASHMIR, near Kulgam which is around 100 kms from Srinagar. Programmes were also conducted in other remote areas such as Tangdaar, Drass, Kargil and Leh regions of the UT of Ladakh which is cut off due to snowfall for winters. The programme benefitted large no of defense personnel, woman, panchayat representatives, youth of the area and members of Ladakh Autonomous Hill Development Council participated in these sessions.

Promoting Sanskrit Language

A key area of focus of the NEP 2020 is promotion of Indian languages, arts and culture and its interlinkages for the growth of the individual and the nation. In consonance with the mandate of NEP-2020, IGNOU has signed MoU with the Central Sanskrit University (CSU), New Delhi, on 27th July 2022, for sharing of expertise and resources. The collaboration primarily seeks to provide enhanced opportunities for enabling flexible learning for a wide spectrum of students through the varied distance learning courses offered by IGNOU. MOU will inter alia help to create Learner Support Centres in these institutions which will benefit students of both the students. Moreover, IGNOU will also be benefitted by the expertise of CSUs to develop new collaborative academic programmes. Immediately after signing of MOU, different Regional Centres of IGNOU coordinated with different regional directorates of CSU to explore possibilities of creation of Learner Support Centres. Four different proposals were finalised during 2022 for further placement in 52nd meeting of Student Support Committee.

4.3 Technology Enabled Interactive Activities Of RSD

Virtual Meetings and Interaction

RSD effectively utilized a digital platform for holding meetings with the Regional Centres, Schools, Divisions, and other stakeholders. During the period of report, a total 76 number of virtual meetings were hosted by RSD on various aspects review of admission, NEP-PDP promotion, preparedness of RCs about convocation, issues related to online programme and eVidyabharti project and so on. Regional Centres were also had in-house meetings for deliberations of various routine and specific activities. During the reporting a total 2079 meetings were organised across the regional centres (Annexure VI).

4.4 Alumni Connect

IGNOU has a registered Alumni Association and has created a dynamic portal for online registration. A Facebook page for sharing of experience to strengthen the alumni network has been created. As per IDP-2030 guidelines, RSD initiated Alumni meetings by engaging with the RCs through weekly alumni meetings every Sunday in the year 2021-22. 24 alumni meetings covering 56 RCs were conducted till 6th February 2022. All the Alumni meetings were livestreamed on the Alumni Facebook page and RC Facebook page.

The Alumni Meet-2.0 will begin on 1st January 2023 for the flagship MBA program involving the faculty of School of Management Studies and all RCs.

4.5 Monitoring of RC Activities

RSD monitors the activities of the Regional Centres every month for which data obtained from the Regional Centres through a prescribed — structured format. The data is collected and compiled under various parameters including the Academic Activities of Regional Centers and Learner Support Centers, and Finance & Accounts related matters, i.e., expenditures incurred by Regional Centers and Learner Support Centers are also analysed. The major components of analysis of monthly monitoring reports (MMR) are outlined -

- Activities of Regional Centers: The analysis includes Digital promotional initiatives/activities like use of digital platforms to enhance outreach, press / media publicity releases and meetings/orientation programs through digital platforms for LSC functionaries.
- Monitoring of LSCs: The section includes monitoring of counselling sessions held at Learner Support Centres and other activities of LSCs like induction meetings, grievance redressal and number of scanned copies of assignments received and evaluated at LSCs.
- **Student Support Services:** This part consists of the number of student queries handled and utilization of SMS for communication with students.

- Academic development Activities: This point of analysis encompassed Faculty Development Programme, Webinar/Seminar organized/participated, Radio/TV program etc.
- Expenditure of Regional Centers: The expenditure incurred for operations of Regional Centers and Learner Support Centers have been analyzed. For the Regional Centre, the points of analysis included Regular Staff Salary, Daily Wage payment, Security, Building Rent, Travel and hiring of taxi, Printing/Publicity, Meeting/workshop/Orientation Programme etc. For the Learner Support Centers, the expenditure was analyzed based on Salary of Part Time functionaries and Counselling, Assignment Evaluation, Practical's etc
- Use of digital media: In this section details about the use of various digital and social media by the Regional Centres are included.
- Other Events: In addition to above items, RCs provides brief report of any other activity/events like Promotional, Induction, Coordinator meetings, Orientation Programme, Seminar, Extension outreach programme, UBA, ECP etc.


4.6 Standardizing RC Operations

RSD has developed the following 16 Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for RC operations which have been approved in the 50th and 51st SSC meetings.

Structure of SOP - SOP consists of 16 Chapters covering above activities/operations, which have been compiled into a "*Manual of Standard Operating Procedures*". The structure of SOP is as -

- *Academic Activities* Pre-Admission counselling, Academic counselling (T&P), Assignments and TEE, Projects, WS, IS, ECP, seminars.
- Administration & Finance Finance & Accounts operations, disposal of obsolete materials
- *Monitoring* Regional Centers and Study Centers
- Functioning of LSC/WC Opening and closing SC/WC and appointment of Coordinators
- Facilitating of learners with disabilities and their caregivers.
- Student grievance redressal

The Manual of SOP was launched by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Prof. Nageshwar Rao, on the occasion of inauguration of the "Celebration of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat Week of the University" in virtual mode on 24-02-2022.

Development of White Papers on Students Support Services (in process)

In order to standardize the operations, to plan student support activities and to find out the gaps in existing scheme of things it was decided that white papers on Students Support Services should be brought out. The earlier white papers on support services were brought out by the University in 2013. However significant expansion of the system has taken place during the past 9 years. Detailed formats have been prepared by RSD to collect the data during 2022 which is in the process of compilation and analysis. Exclusive format has been developed to examine the gaps in students support for PWD learners. The key objective of developing this exclusive questionnaire is to acquire information about support services provided to PWD learners at RC at various stages from entry up to exit from the university. These support services include Infrastructure facilities, academic and administrative support during admission time, counselling, submission of assignment and conducting Term End Exam etc.

Optimal utilization of Regional Centre's Operations

During the past two years, there have been major changes in the strategic framework for providing student support services in IGNOU. These changes have created new opportunities to enhance outreach at a much-lowered cost. The major trends are as follows:

- a) University has been exploring new dimensions of learner support and programme delivery through optimal utilization of ICT-enabled, blended and online modes. Such technological applications have opened up new options to provide support services over much bigger geographical area at a reduced cost. Technology has also enabled the RCs to extend support to overseas learners thereby extending the RC jurisdiction to international level.
- b) Due to major shift in mode of programme delivery from the traditional ODL to blended and digital modes responsibilities have been assigned to Regional Centers for cross border learner support extended in some professional programmes by way of utilizing a national resource base.
- c) In a recent initiative, some of the RCs have been assigned the status of Nodal Centre as the single point contact for providing academic support to learners enrolled in specific academic programmes across the country.

In view of the above it is advisable to dispense with the existence of multiple Regional Centres in the same geographical location. Moreover, the RCs in remote locations are at a disadvantage because of poor connectivity and are not adequately equipped to provide technology-enabled, digital and online support services. In order to better serve the remote and disadvantaged learners, RSD strategized to shift the operations of identified RCs to a neighbouring RC, which is better equipped in terms of connectivity and access to technology. In the above context, the operations of the Regional Centres Chandigarh and Bhagalpur were scaled down and shifted to Karnal and Patna respectively. It will not only help to bring about cost effectiveness of operations but will also help to avoid duplication of effort and enable judicious use of resources to provide quality learner support services.

Standardizing the payment procedures of Online Programmes

IGNOU has launched a range of academic programmes in the online mode along with the programmes in ODL mode, for the July 2022 session. It is also providing online academic support services to international learners in GOAL Guyana project. Further, the AICTE has also granted approval to IGNOU for admission of 10000 seats in MBA OL programme, 10000 seats in MCA OL programme for the year 2022-23. Now the University is venturing in a big way into the online programmes and extend their delivery through all RCs across the country. There is need to engage the qualified and experienced faculty (as per UGC norms) in Universities/Colleges, as academic counsellors for high quality and effective learner support services.

With the initiatives taken by Regional Services Division, a committee was formed by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor and the matter was deliberated in a meeting chaired by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor. It was decided that rates for academic counselling for both ODL and online programmes shall remain the same. However, in case of online programmes, computer/data charges shall be paid instead of conveyance charges as the counsellors shall conduct counselling sessions either from home or from

their workplace. Since data charges are same across the country the amount paid for this purpose shall remain same throughout the country.

Standardizing the Operations of RC-LSC

Since the establishment of RC-LSCs in 2021, there was a felt need to standardize their operations and develop guidelines for operational modalities and staffing pattern at the RC-LSC. The RSD took feedback about the underlying operational issues in the RC-LSCs and developed draft guidelines for placement in 52nd SSC. Specific draft guidelines were prepared for staffing patterns, space requirements, arrangements for practical counselling, financial transactions and working hours.

5. VARIED DIMENSIONS OF LEARNER SUPPORT AT REGIONAL CENTERS


5.1 Capacity Building

Awareness Development Programme-NEP 2020

The IGNOU has been entrusted by the GOI for training 15.01 lakh University and College teachers in a period of six months. The training will be imparted with the broad objective of sensitizing and creating awareness for implementation of the NEP 2020 through the Professional Development Programme (PDP). The PDP is equivalent to a 6-days short duration Professional Development Programme of UGC-HRDC. Regional Centers have an important role in effective implementation of the Programme.

For the successful implementation of the programme, all the RCs are undertaking the following two major responsibilities:

a) **Promotion and Advocacy**: Promote and advertise through all possible media and means, and mobilize teachers to join national NEP-PDP. RCs can plan keeping in view of local requirements. In order to sensitize the Higher Educational Institutions, the University is making efforts to communicate the information to different state governments from the Ministry and from the VC. State wise letters have been issued by the respective government departments of Higher Education (of 22 States & UT) and by 9 Universities. In addition, the RCs have organised several sensitization programmes for College/University faculty to encourage them to take admission in NEP-PDP Programme.



b) **Registration of participants**: The teachers are registering at Samarth-NEP, and support at Swayam-NEP is being handled by the HQ Team. The RC's officials have been sensitized about the process of registration of participants for NEP-PDP. The scrutiny of the applications submitted by the trainees is the duty of Regional Centres which has been carried out by them well in time. RCs have been coordinating with STRIDE on day-to-day basis to successfully implement the NEP PDP programme.



Special Campaign 2.0

The Special Campaign 2.0 was an initiative of the GOI with a focus on 11 different parameters including cleanliness and record management in all government offices and departments to create clean and spacious working environments. The campaign was organized in two phases, i.e., the preparatory phase from 14th to 30th September 2022 and the implementation phase from 2nd to 31st October 2022. The brief details of the activities carried out during these two phases are given in Annexures. All RCs of IGNOU undertook activities focusing on the 11 parameters as per the GOI guidelines. Various activities were organized by RCs such as webinars on the themes of waste management, cleanliness, 3Rs (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle), record management (weeding out obsolete items, records, space creation), e-waste management in fulfillment of the objectives of the Special Campaign 2.0. Regional Centre have reported that around Rs 2643886/- could be realized through the disposal of obsolete materials during the period of special campaign. It also resulted in creation of space for office use. The reports from Regional Centers reveal that prior to campaign the space occupied by obsolete materials was 56627 sq ft and with the efforts made by Regional Centers 31235 sq ft was freed by way of disposal of obsolete materials. During the special campaign intensive efforts were also made to significantly bring down the pending matters on I-Gram, RTI, CPGRAM, Referred matters from MP/VIPs/State Governments/Ministries, Inter-ministerial references, public grievances etc. Few glimpses of these activities are given below:
