Regional Centre, Hyderabad reached an understanding with Deaf and Dumb to sponsor their eligible students to enrol for UG/PG programmes of IGNOU. In this regard Dr.PM Sowjanya, ARD addressed a meeting with this learners of the institute, the institute has sponsored 30 students for July 2022 session for UG programmes and for current session i.e. July 2023 session it is 60.





NGOs at Peoples Education Trust one prominent NGO at Siddipet working for the above cause, called "Sankalp" on our behest organized awareness meeting among the students of Vikas vocational training centre on employable programmes of IGNOU.

The primary objective of this awareness programme is that a fairly large number of students studying or getting trained in vocational courses do not have awareness of IGNOU programmes and their employability.




4. NOIDA

The following efforts have been made towards promotion of inclusive education by IGNOU Regional Centre, NOIDA:

- An Online Educational awareness programme was organized for the students enrolled at National Skill Training Institute, Women (NSTI-W), Sector 1, NOIDA on 11th January, 2023 and they were apprised about the modalities of admission in IGNOU programmes and also about the facilities and flexibilities provided by IGNOU. They were also informed about the UGC Notification regarding scheme of pursuing two UG/PG programmes simultaneously.
- In collaboration with the School of Gender and Development Studies (SOGDS), IGNOU, a webinar for IGNOU Regional Centres on Newly Launched Programmes of SOGDS was organized by IGNOU Regional Centre, NOIDA on 25th January, 2023. The Director, SOGDS, Prof. Himadri Roy addressed the participants and provided information about various newly launched programmes of the School. It was followed by the presentations by the School Faculty members on BA (Gender Studies) (BAGS), Certificate in Gender in Law (CGSL), Certificate in Gender and Science (CGSCI), Certificate in Gender, Agriculture and Sustainable Development (CGAS) and Diploma In Women Empowerment and Development (DWED) programmes, respectively. They apprised the participants about the background of the programmes, objectives, programme structure, target population, eligibility criteria, etc. and requested the Regional Centres to extend cooperation in popularization of the programmes offered by SOGDS and smooth delivery of learner support services to the learners including academic counseling support.
- Online pre-admission counseling was organized by IGNOU RC NOIDA on 31st October, 2022 in order to familiarize the prospective students with comprehensive information and acquaint them with the diverse range of programs offered by IGNOU. In-depth discussions illuminated the unique features of IGNOU, potential career trajectories associated with the programmes

- aiding students in making informed decisions aligned with their aspirations. The session delved into the intricacies of the admission process, providing a step-by-step guide on how to apply for admission. The interactive nature of the sessions allowed for a personalized approach, addressing specific queries and concerns raised by prospective students.

IGNOU RC takes initiatives in disseminating information about the educational opportunities available in ODL and Online modes in general and opportunities available in IGNOU in particular among the





6. Shimla
